

Audit Findings Identify Magnitude of Unreported RAL Pool Attendance



The City's failure to accurately report RAL pool attendance prompts community to quantify impacts.



(The term City generally refers to the Iowa City Parks & Recreation Department.)

Community sponsors audit to verify actual RAL pool attendance.

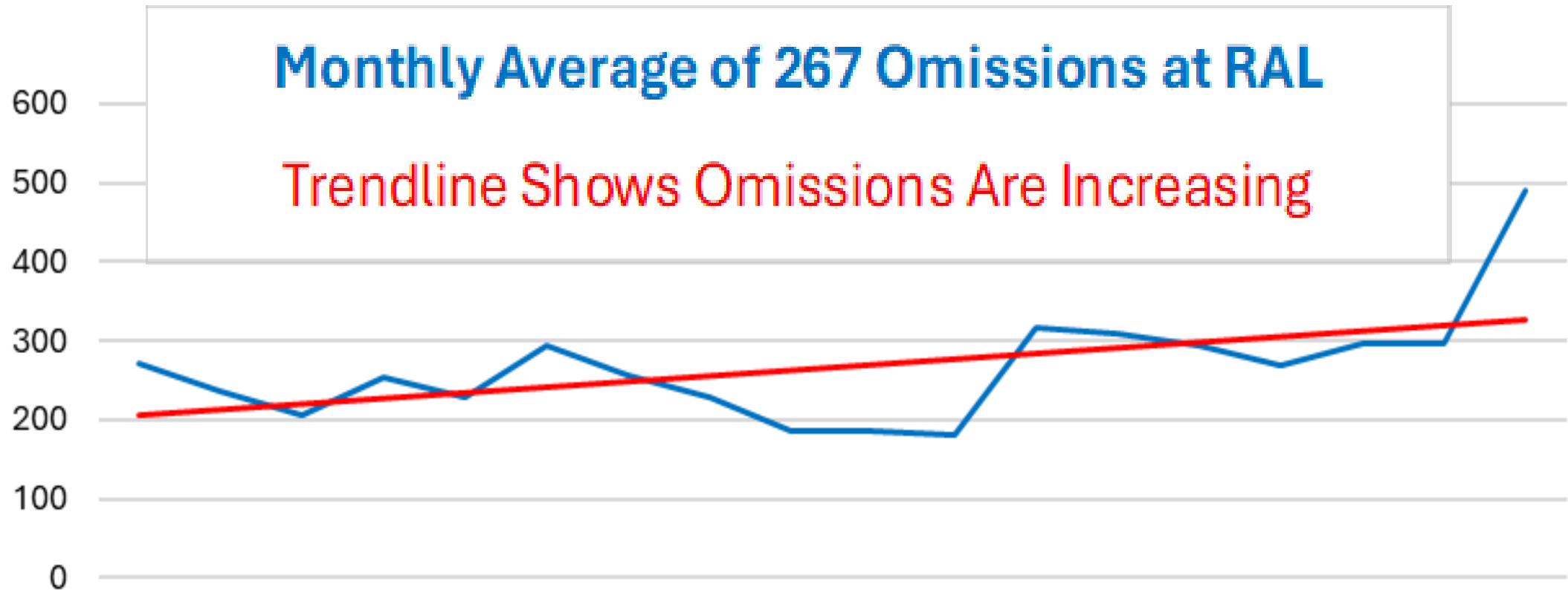


Citizens purchased over 665 hours of video footage and additional public records for analysis and comparison to official pool reports.

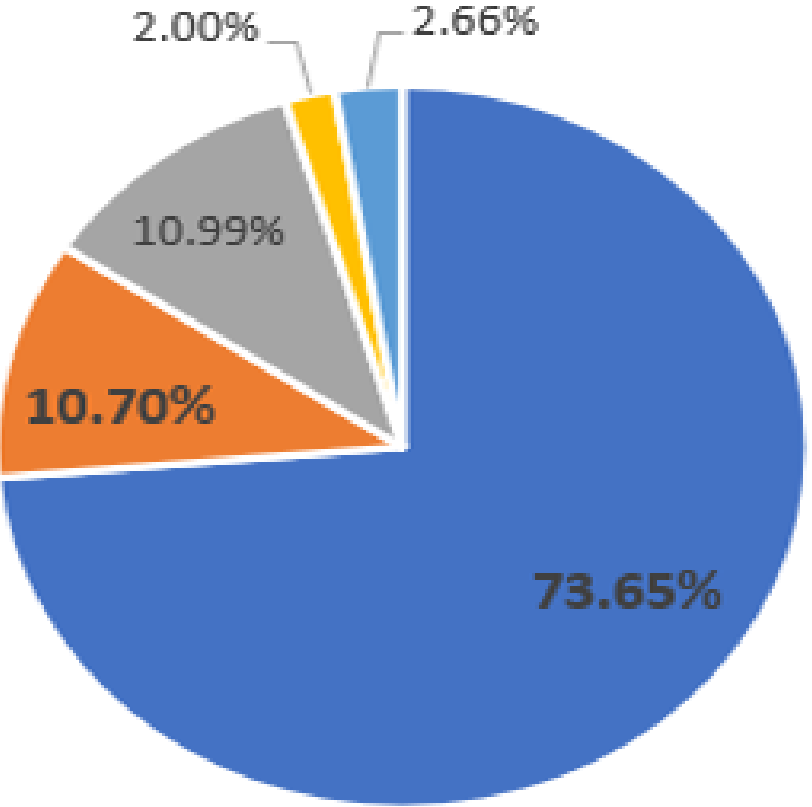


Audit results established average monthly omissions, quantifying the amount of verified RAL pool use omitted from the City's reports.

RAL pool use omitted from City reports is substantial and escalating.



Monthly average of unreported RAL pool use, by type.

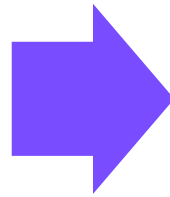

City dismisses community's solution.

November 2024

Community members propose a compromise of **238** be added to RAL monthly attendance report values.

(238 = verified average omissions, less intentionally unreported training category.)



The City admits defects in their measurement methods but **makes no commitment to change their flawed reporting.**



Impacts of inaccurate reports continue to grow.

Over 8,800 instances of RAL pool use have been omitted from City attendance reports.

(October 2022 – June 2025)
