

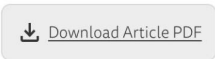
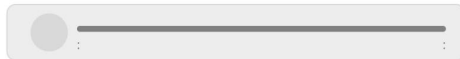
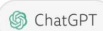

The white oak picks more dark brown and beige undertones and is much darker than the red oak. It has a smaller grain variety giving it a straight and uniform appearance. On the Janka Scale, the white oak has a higher score of 1360 compared to the red oak with a score of 1290. Whichever of the two you choose, the legendary oak will add beauty and comfort to your home with ease. And like fine wine, your floor will keep getting better with time.

Walnut is a softer hardwood compared to the oak but it does come with a ton of character. Boasting vibrant mid-toned hues, a walnut floor is a good choice if effortless elegance is what you desire for your home. The most popular and readily available variety of walnut flooring is the American Walnut also known as the Eastern or Black Walnut which makes it a cost-effective option for your home. This variety is darker and has a richer chocolate-brown color. The grain is typically straight and open but some cuts may contain some slight curves and variations. Other varieties include the European or English walnut which come with lighter honey undertones with hints of red, orange, and gray. The walnut hardwood flooring comes strong with a rating of 1010 on the Janka Scale. It's no doubt a favorite for homeowners searching for warmth, beauty, and sophistication.

3. Cherry

Cherry is a unique breathtaking hardwood. It has a rich light brown color that patinas over time (usually between six months to one year) turning it to a deep red hue. The most popular variety of cherry wood is the locally available American Cherry which has distinct flowing grain patterns, a hardness rating of 950, and can easily resemble other tropical exotic species. If you're searching for a more exotic flooring product for your home, you can choose between Brazilian and African cherry hardwoods. These red-colored floors are renowned for their uniform grain and their ability to take on a variety of stains and finishes. What's more, they have a strong rating of 2350 on the Janka Scale. 4. Ash
