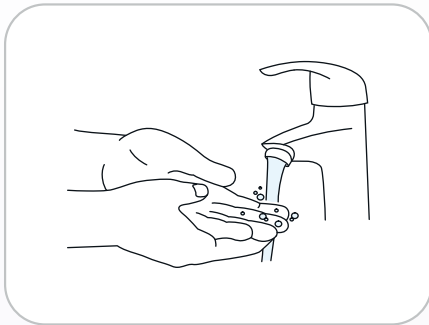
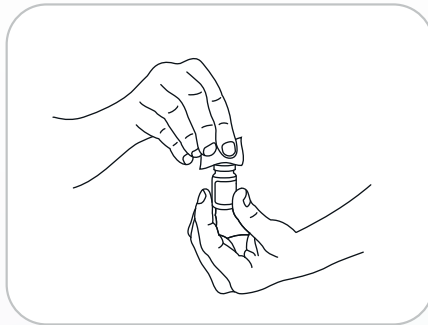


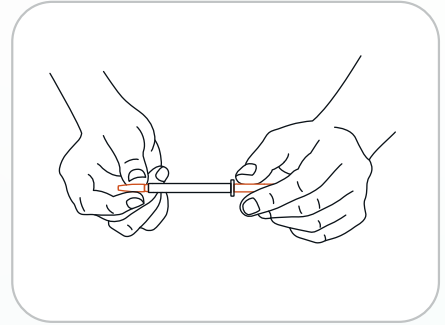
Subcutaneous Injection Guide



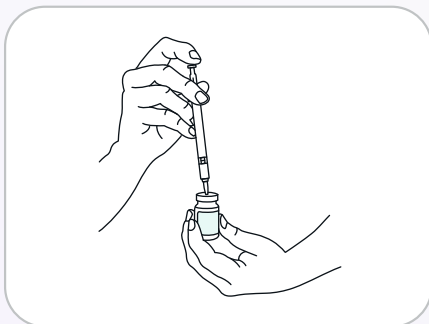
Wash your hands thoroughly and dry them completely. If your peptide has been refrigerated, allow it to reach room temperature for 10-15 minutes before proceeding.



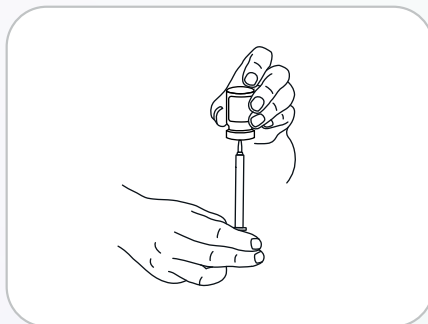
Clean the rubber stopper with an alcohol wipe using a circular motion. Allow the alcohol to air dry completely (30-60 seconds).



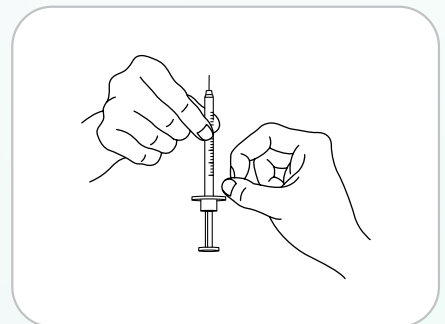
Remove the needle cap, being careful not to touch the needle, and the plunger cap.



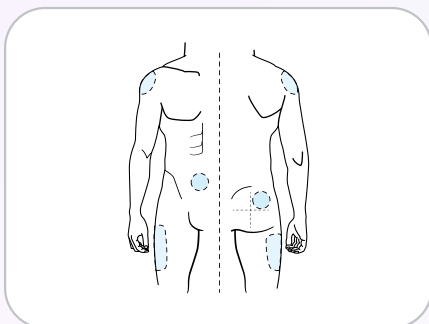
Insert the needle through the rubber stopper of the peptide vial.



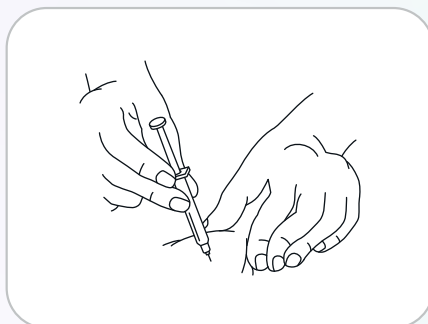
Invert the vial and slowly pull the plunger to draw the desired amount of solution. Remove the needle from the vial when finished.



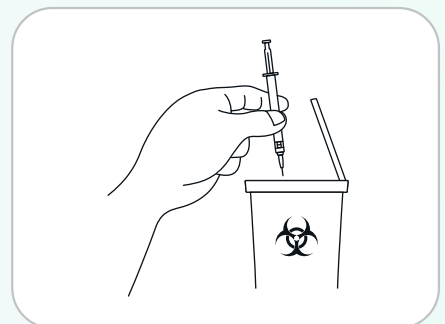
Remove the needle from the vial. Point the needle up and gently tap on the syringe until all bubbles rise. To expell air bubbles contained, slowly push the plunger until a small drop forms on the tip of the needle.



Choose an injection site.



Pinch up the skin at the desired location. Hold the syringe like a pencil at a 45° angle. Inject the solution slowly by pushing down on the plunger.



Immediately dispose of the used syringe and needle in a proper sharps disposal container.
