
Crip Camp Screening + Section 504 Panel A social narrative

I am attending the screening of *Crip Camp* today. We will watch the movie and then listen to a panel discussion about **Section 504**.



There is **accessible parking** in the lot and on-street parking.





Once inside, I can go to the box office to reserve a ticket, or go to the will-call table and find my ticket.

In the lobby, I will find concessions and can pick up my **free popcorn** or find a place to sit while I wait for the theater to open.








If I need a **restroom**, they are located in the hallway next to the theater entrance.

After the film is over, I can stay in my seat to hear from the **Section 504** panel. I can ask a question or just listen.








When the event is over, I will leave the way that I came in.
