Assess your Life Which of the means of a humble mindset in v1 do you find most difficult? Which do you find easiest or most readily available for you? How have you reversed the order of identity and image in your experience – seeking your identity through a self-image you've created? What is/was the result of that reversal? As in the example of Eric Liddell, who has modeled Christlike humility in your life?
