



Post-op Instructions after Pulpotomies

Your child's procedure today involved a baby root canal on one or more teeth. This means we removed some or all of the nerve to save the tooth. It's common for the area to feel a bit tender afterward, but you can manage any discomfort with a dose of Children's Tylenol or Motrin.

Even though these teeth have been treated, they will eventually fall out on their own just like normal baby teeth—though they can sometimes dissolve a little earlier than expected. We will use X-rays during future check-ups to keep an eye on them and make sure they are coming out as they should.
