## **Re: Required Reporting Reminders**

This is to remind you that the following *required* reports are due in the upcoming weeks.

- 1. HERDS due **daily** Monday thru' Friday
- 2. NHSN Covid-19 cases and vaccinations for staff and residents **due weekly**.
- 3. NHSN Healthcare Personnel Influenza Vaccination Summary 2023-2024 flu season is **due May 15, 2024**. This report can be accessed via the Healthcare Personnel Safety (HPS) component of NHSN.

- 4. Influenza, Surveillance, and Reporting 2023 2024 season. This longitudinal report for the 2023-2024 flu season is now open and can be accessed via the Health Commerce System. **Due** date is **June 1, 2024**.

- 5. Payroll-Based Journal (PBJ) report for Fiscal Quarter 2 (January 1 to March 31) is **due** on **May 15, 2024**.

Additionally, Public Health Law section 2803-c-2, becomes **effective May 28, 2024**. This law establishes that it is unlawful for a nursing home or adult care facility to take or fail to take certain actions, wholly or partially, based on a resident's actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) status (see <a href="here">here</a>). As such, we encourage you to begin to review existing policies and procedures and update as appropriate to ensure compliance with these requirements. The Association has reached out to the Department to inquire whether there will be any NYS recommended or required training. Per the Department, training materials are under review with anticipation that a final SAGECare product will be available by the end of May.
