Re: NYSDOH Bureau of Reimbursement DAL – One Time Investment

The NYSDOH Bureau of Reimbursement issued a NH DAL related to the “One Time Investment,” see attached. Please note, the one-time increase in residential health care funding will soon be disbursed. The processing of this payment will take effect in **cycle 2458** with a check release date of **October 16, 2024**.

As you may recall, the 2024-25 Enacted Budget included a \$285 million gross increase to SNFs, ADHCs, and hospice programs. NYS is distributing this increase as a lump sum payment that has been calculated on a dollar per day basis. Please note, the Federal share will be distributed upon the Federal approval of the methodology. GNYHCFA will be sure to share that information once it’s been determined. State payments were calculated as follows:

- The total available amount of the increase was divided by the total billed Medicaid days for Calendar Year (CY) 2022. The result equates to \$13.55 per day.
- Each nursing home, specialty unit, adult day healthcare, and hospice provider receives a lump sum in the amount of \$13.55 multiplied by their CY 2022 billed Medicaid days.
- This current State share payment accounts for 50% of each provider’s full gross lump sum amount.

During the NYSDOH Division of Reimbursement call that GNYHCFA participated in, the Department stated that the Medicaid reimbursement transition to PDPM is a work in progress. NYS is working with consultant group Myers and Stauffer. NYSDOH indicated they will keep Associations and stakeholders up to date and involved in the process. There is no current date for implementation yet.
