Our work supports the two main drivers of Nevada's workforce — employers and workers. There are four keyways we support these groups:



Job-specific worker training

We connect career seekers with job training in high-growth industries, including healthcare, manufacturing, logistics and digital technology. To ensure training is specific and relevant to employer needs, we partner with local training providers, including community colleges. We also provide funding for employers to offer upskilling and apprenticeships.



Assistance with barriers to training or work

Often, the thing standing between a worker and the new job they want is something we can help with. From transportation assistance to financial support for supplies and equipment, Nevadaworks connects eager career seekers with the resources they need to gain employment and get on a good career path with opportunities to advance.
