Product Description: FreeWill's Partner Portal is a centralized platform that gives nonprofit fundraisers real-time visibility into their planned and smart giving pipeline, donor activity, and campaign performance.

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Evaluation Methods Used: Accessibility testing was conducted manually by 7 auditors including one with visual disabilities. The following tools were used for evaluation.

- Keyboard-only testing on all browsers
- Contrast testing using Colour Contrast Analyser by TPGi
- Screen reader testing using the following tools:
 - NVDA with FireFox on Windows
 - JAWS with Chrome on Windows

- VoiceOver with Safari on macOS
- VoiceOver with Safari on iOS
- Talkback with Chrome on Android OS
