- Contrast testing using Colour Contrast Analyser by TPGi
- Screen reader testing using the following tools:
 - NVDA with FireFox on Windows
 - JAWS with Chrome on Windows

- VoiceOver with Safari on macOS
- VoiceOver with Safari on iOS
- Talkback with Chrome on Android OS

These fields can still be completed by typing the relevant data. Some screen readers are unable to read menu options from the expandable menus in the navigation bar that represent pages the user is not meant to reach yet. This does not impact the user's ability to access these pages as they progress through the user flow. The birthdate picker menu is inaccessible to some screen readers. The field can still be completed by typing the information.
