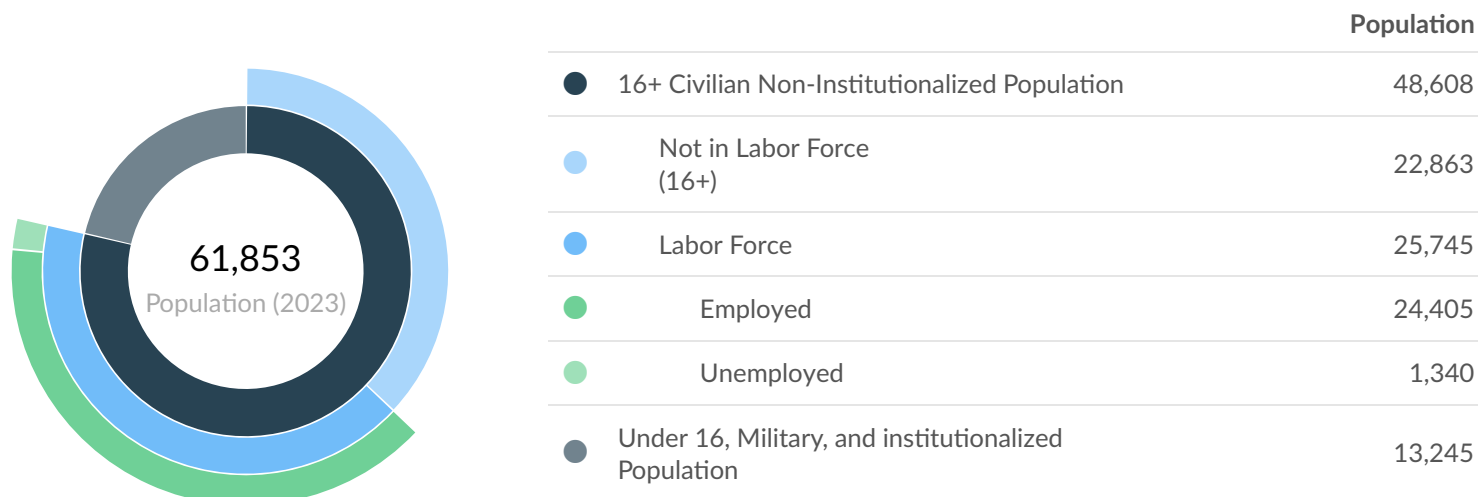
Median household income is **\$6.8K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 10.6%** since 2017, growing by 5,805. Population is expected to **increase by 11.1%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 6,703.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **increased by 1.1%** in Carson City County, NV from 30,847 to **31,195**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 2.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 57.2% to 54.4% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.7% of Carson City County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.1% below the national average), and **10.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.

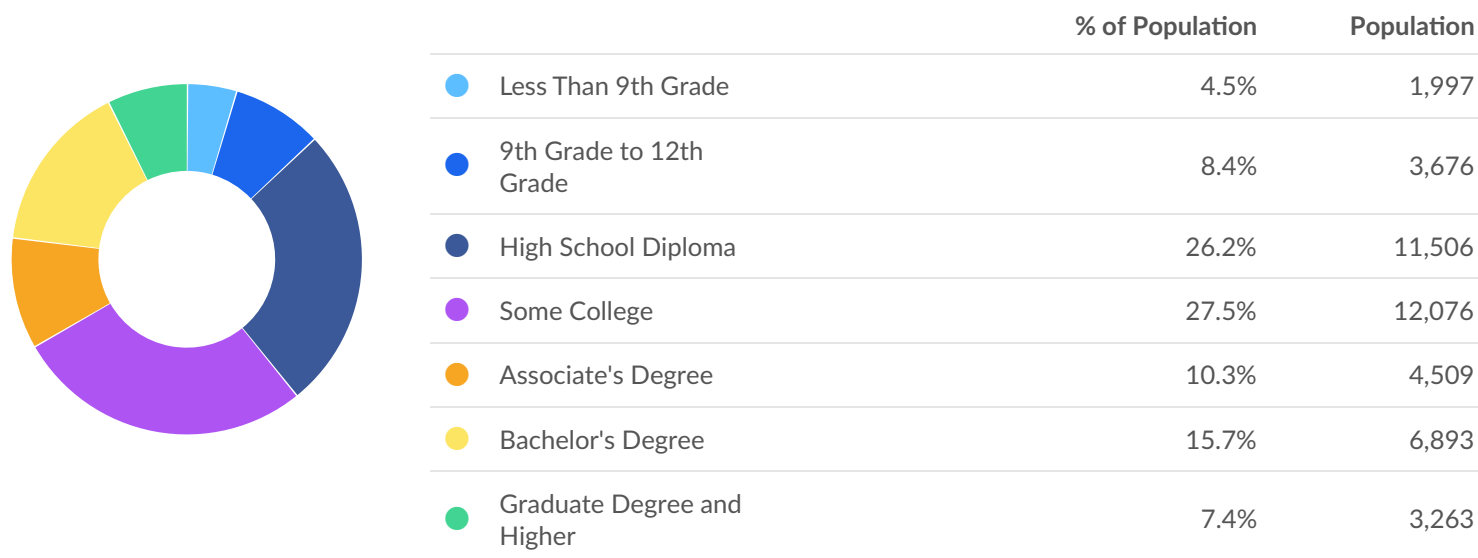

Jan 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



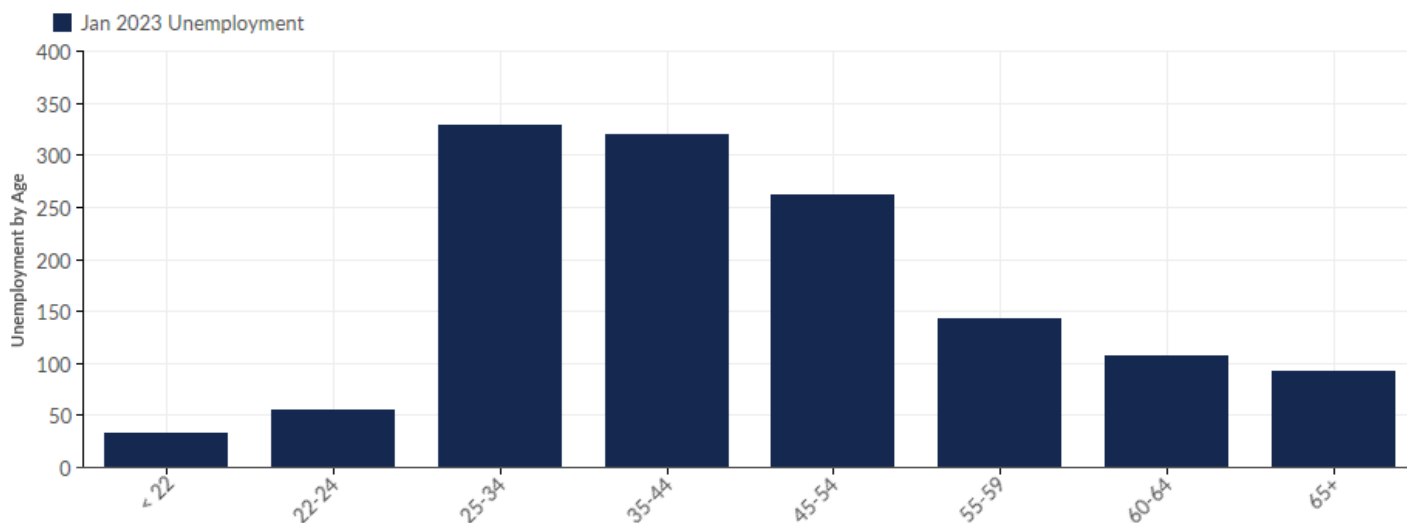
Educational Attainment

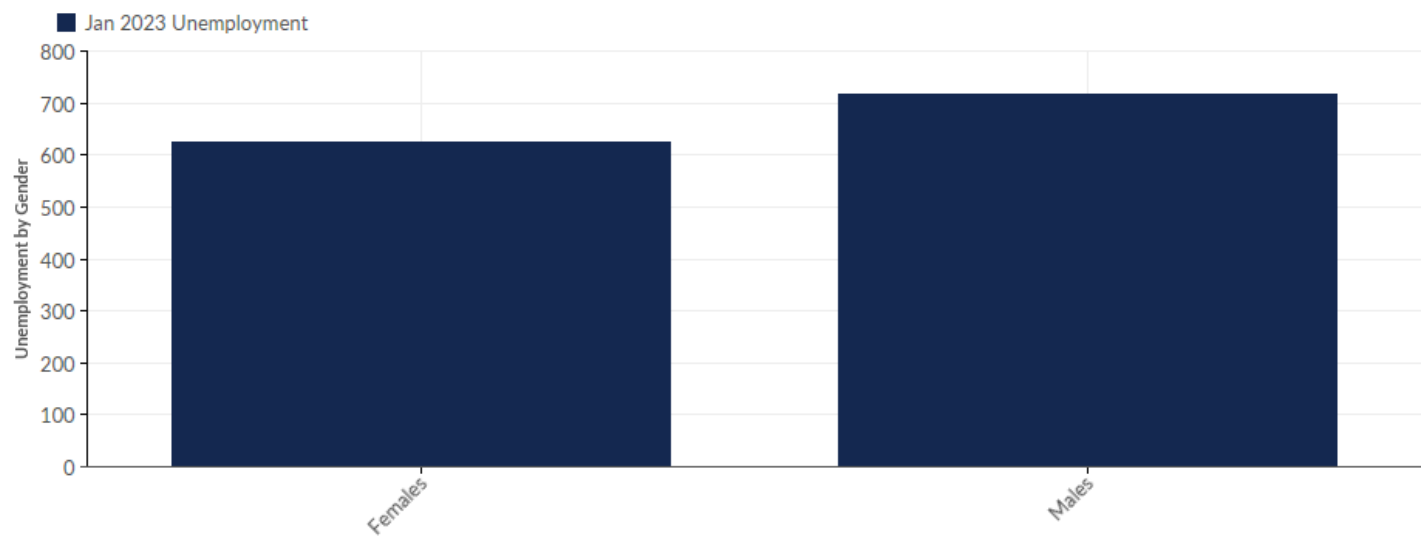

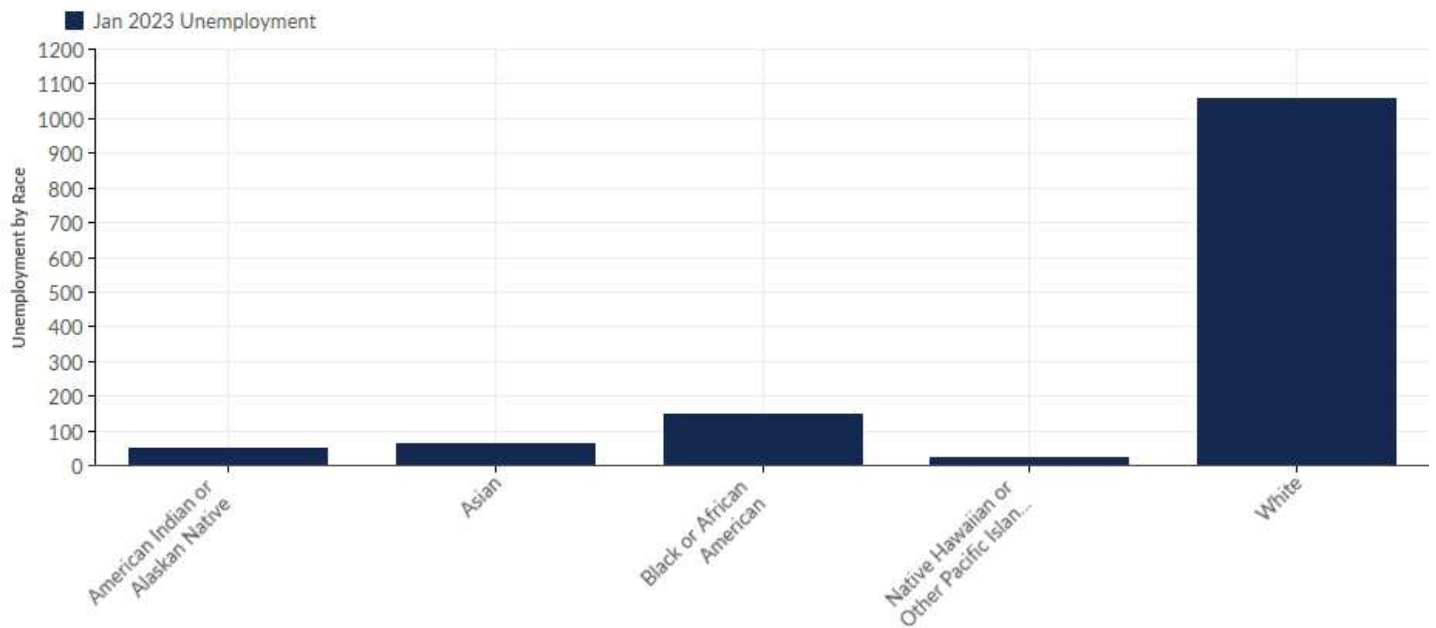

Unemployment by Gender



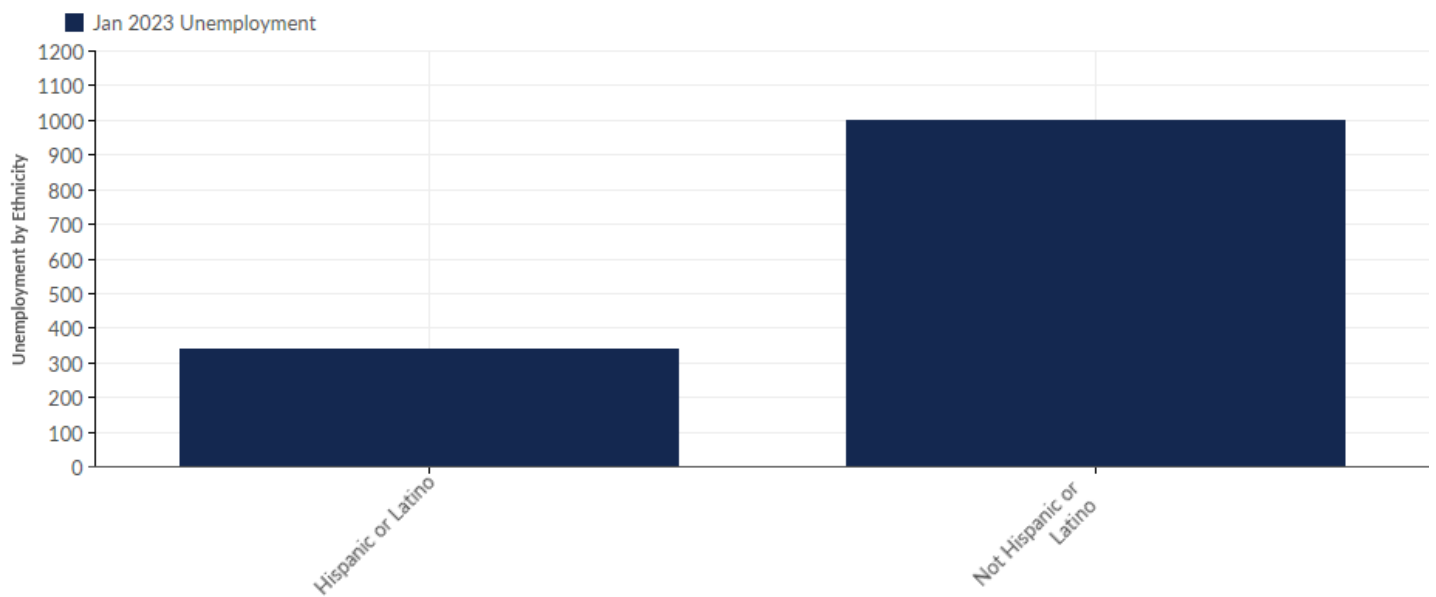

Unemployment by Ethnicity

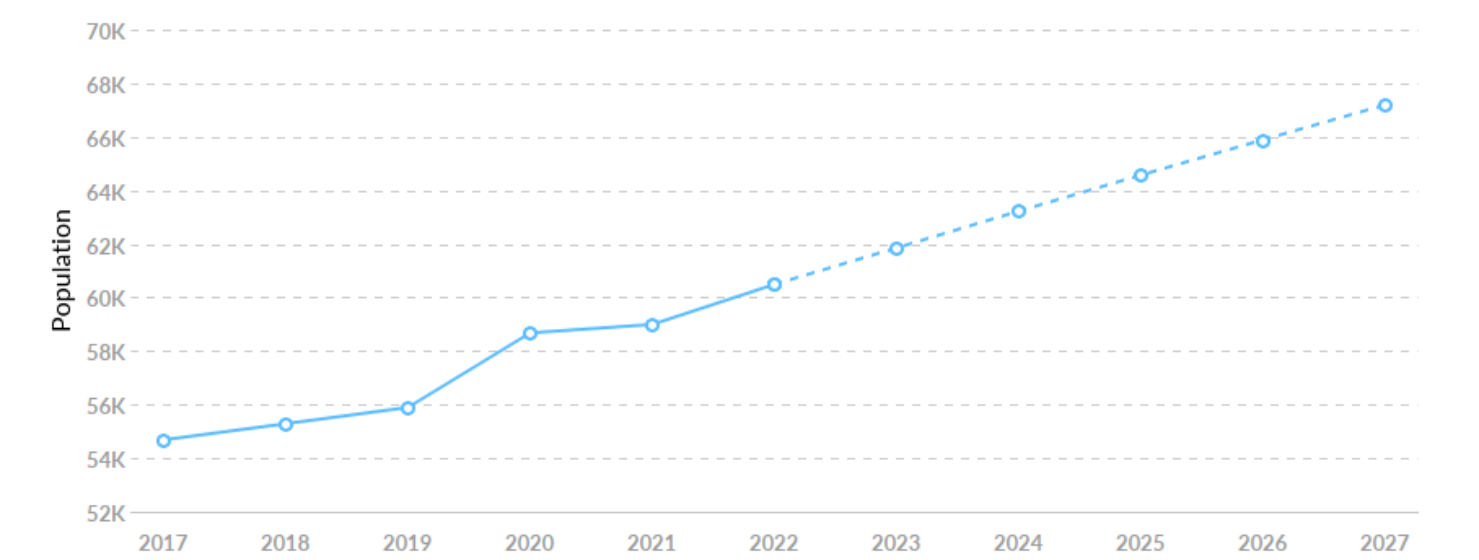

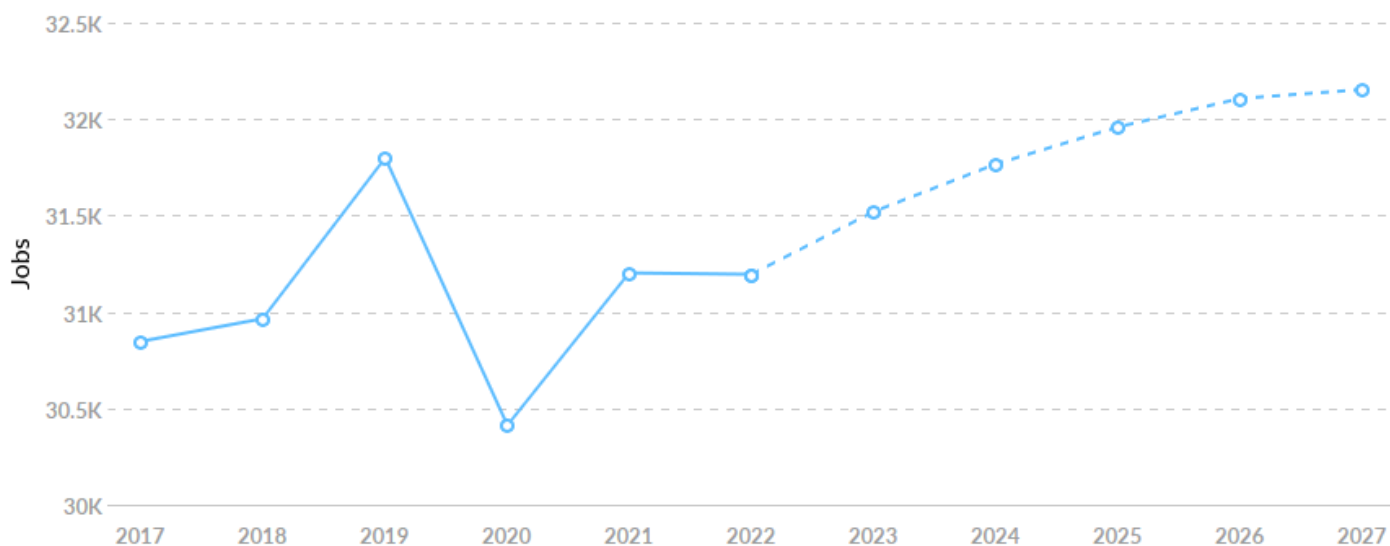

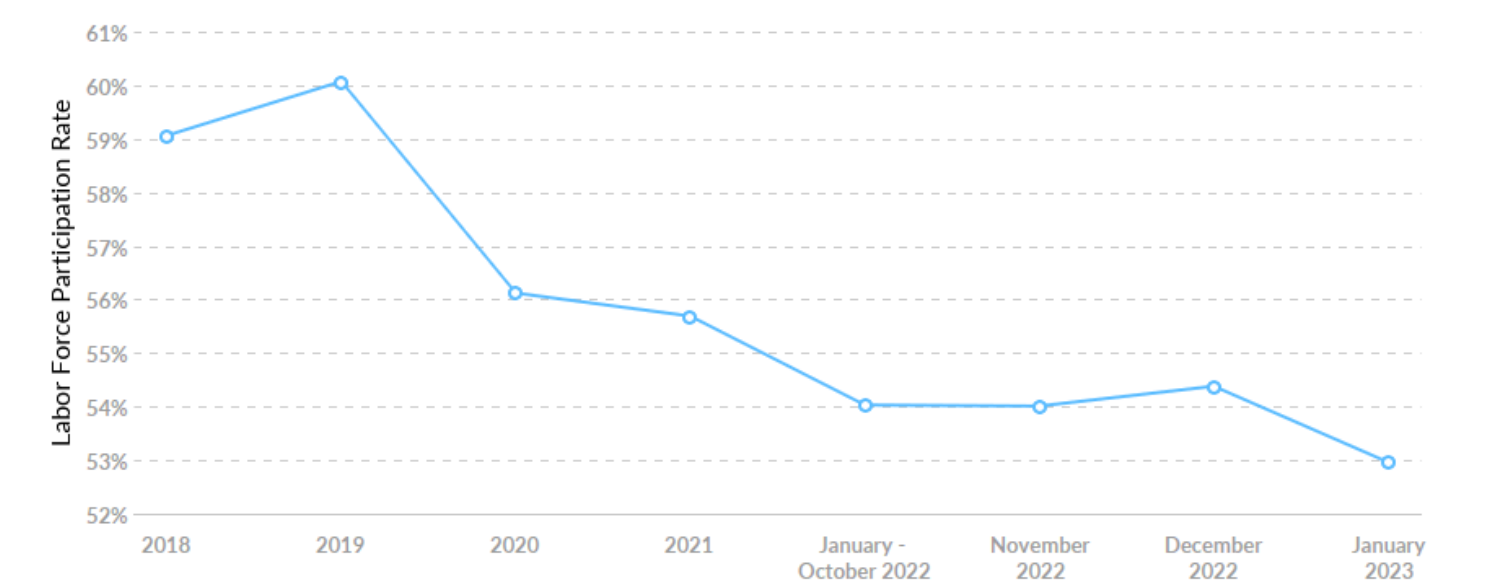
Job Trends

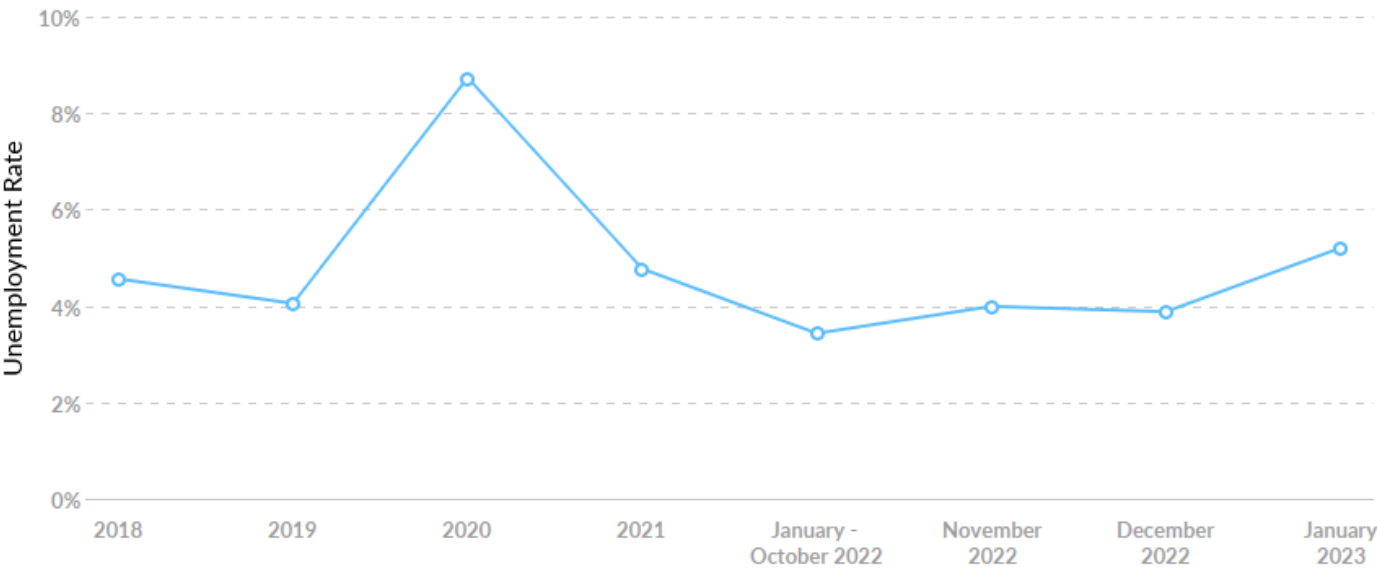

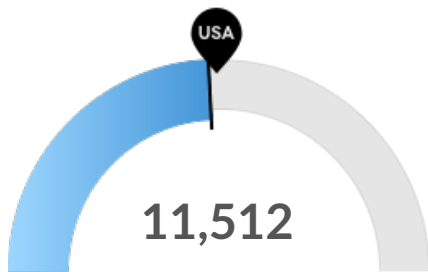
Unemployment Rate Trends

Carson City County, NV had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 5.20%, **increasing from 4.56%** 5 years before.



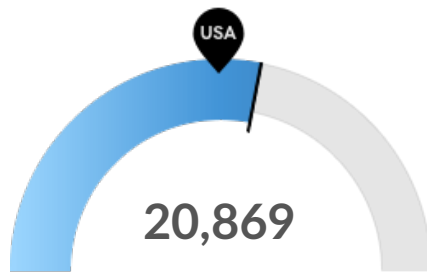

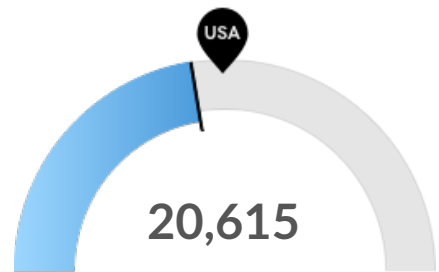
Millennials

Carson City County, NV has 11,512 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 12,050.



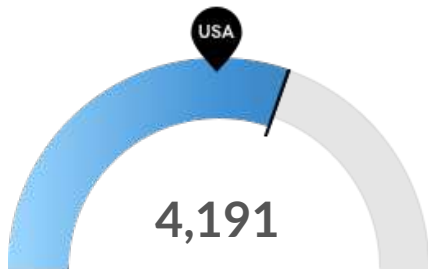
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Carson City County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 17,535 people 55 or older, while there are 20,869 here.



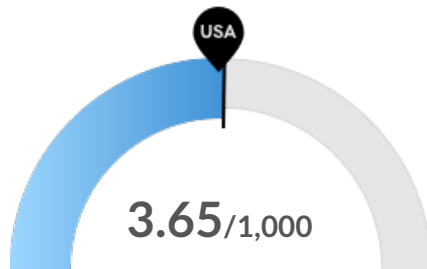
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Carson City County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 24,007 racially diverse people, while there are 20,615 here.



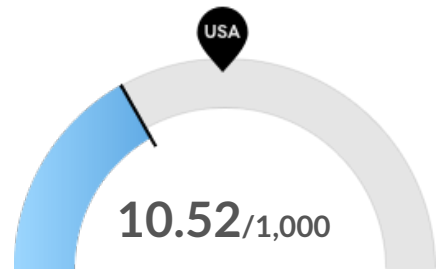
Veterans

Carson City County, NV has 3.65 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

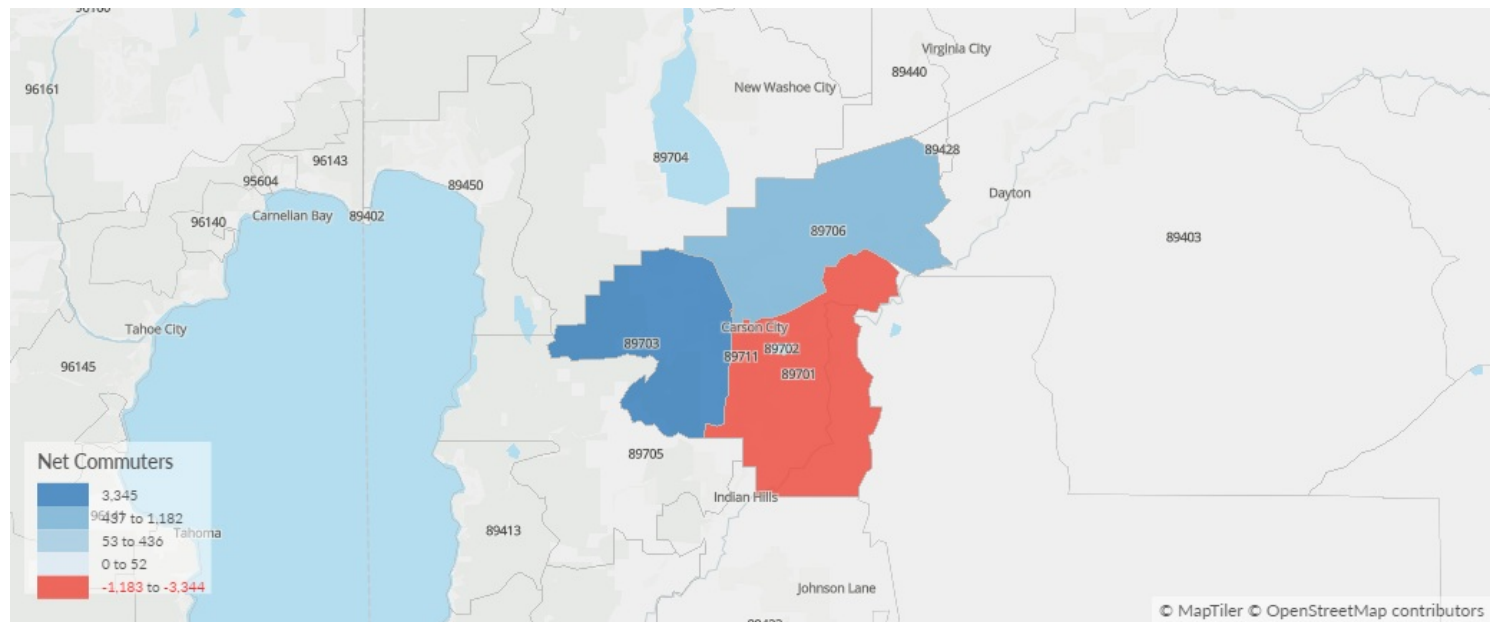


Property Crime

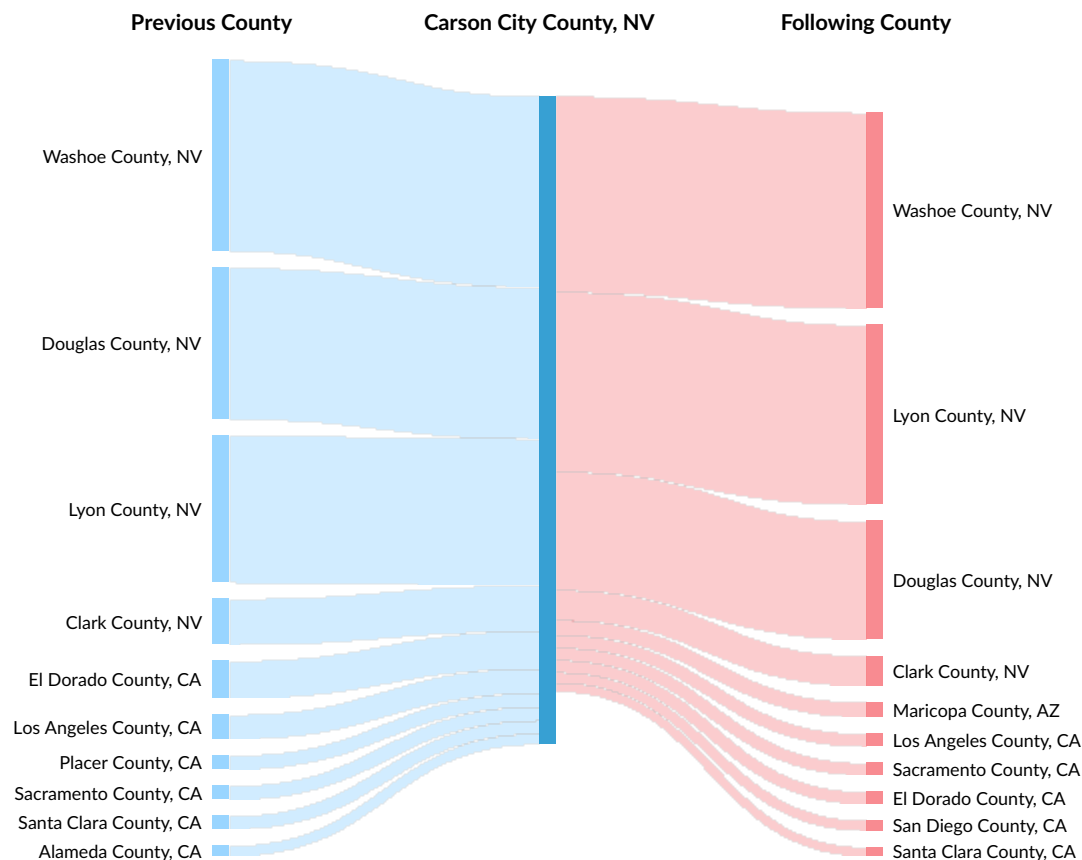

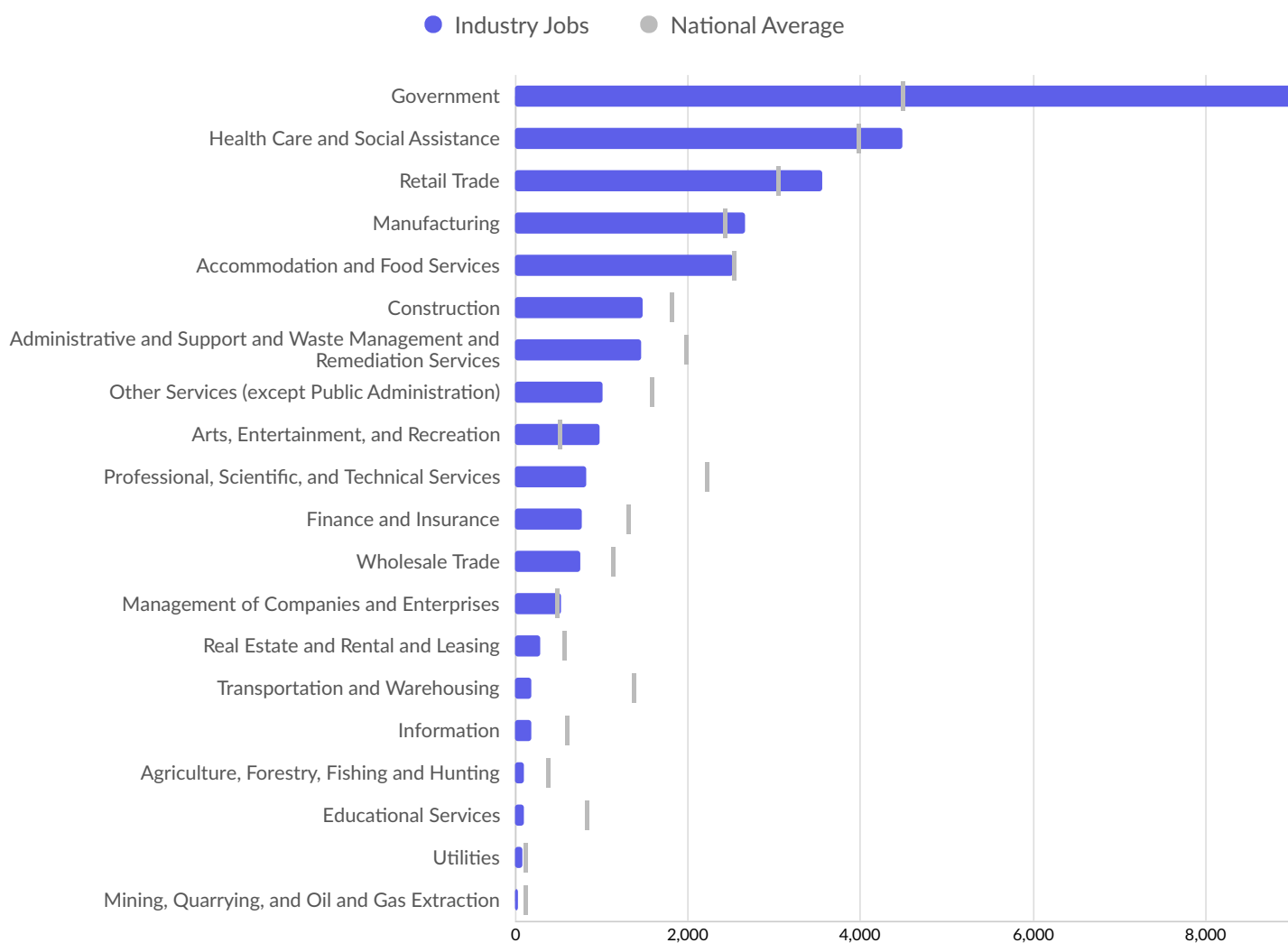

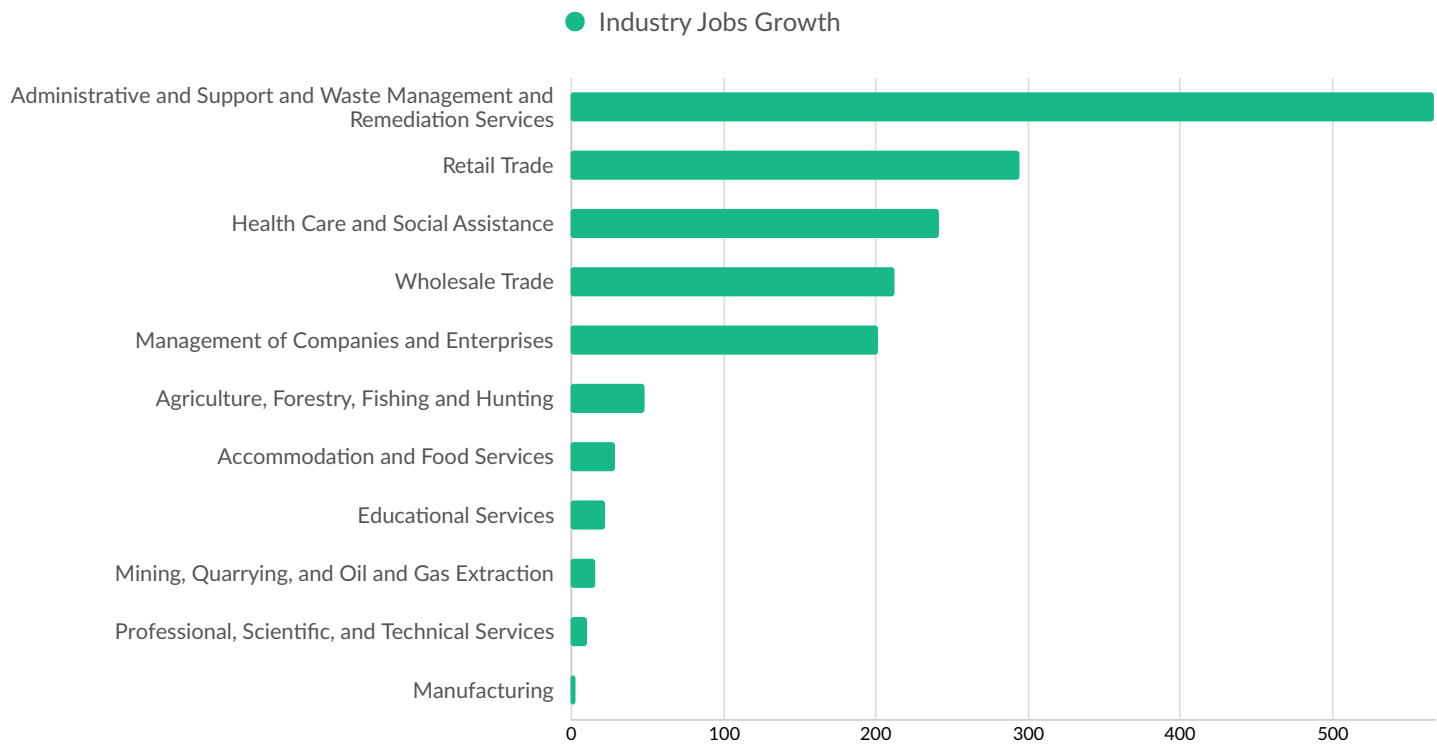

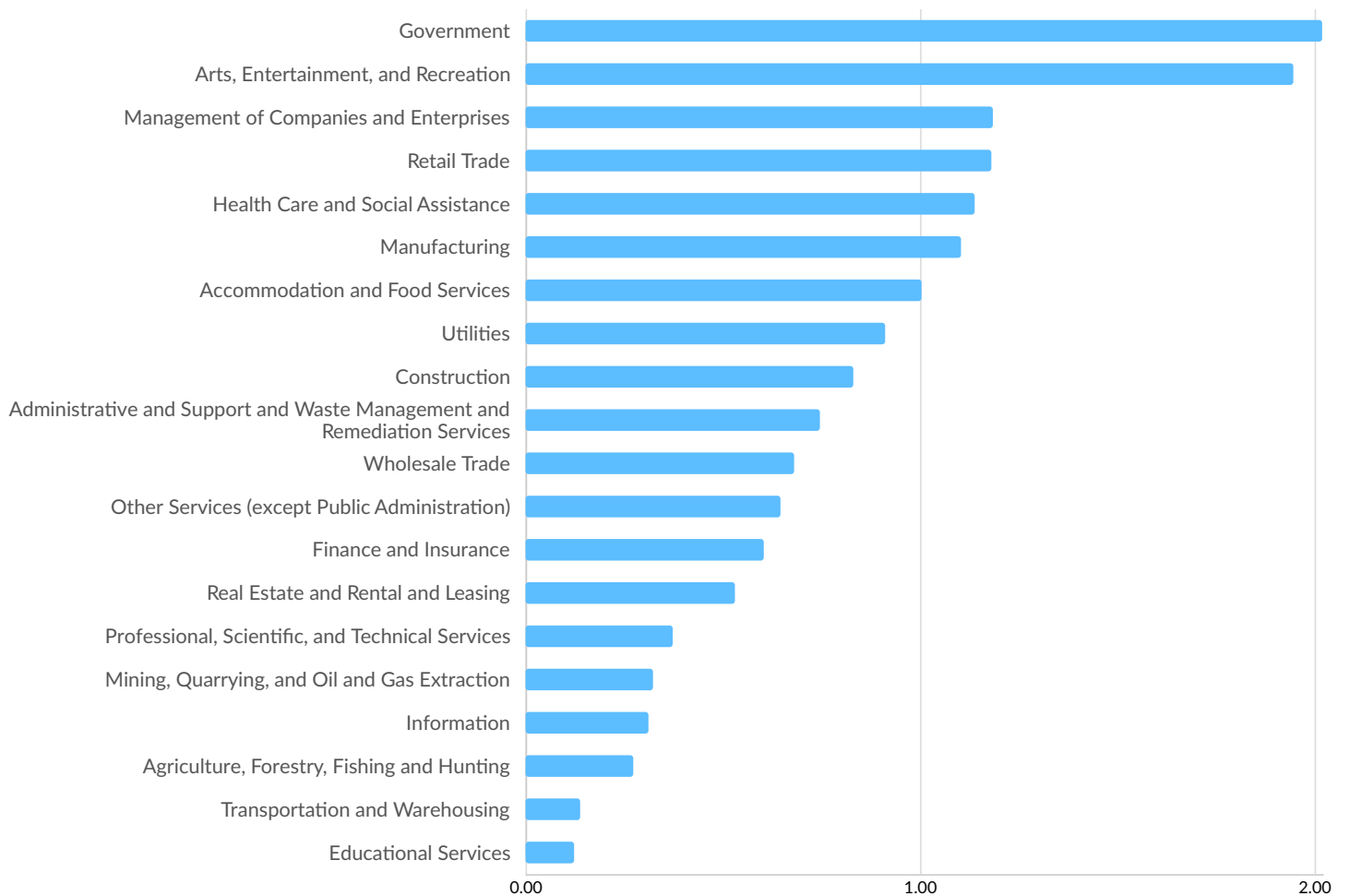


Top Growing Industries



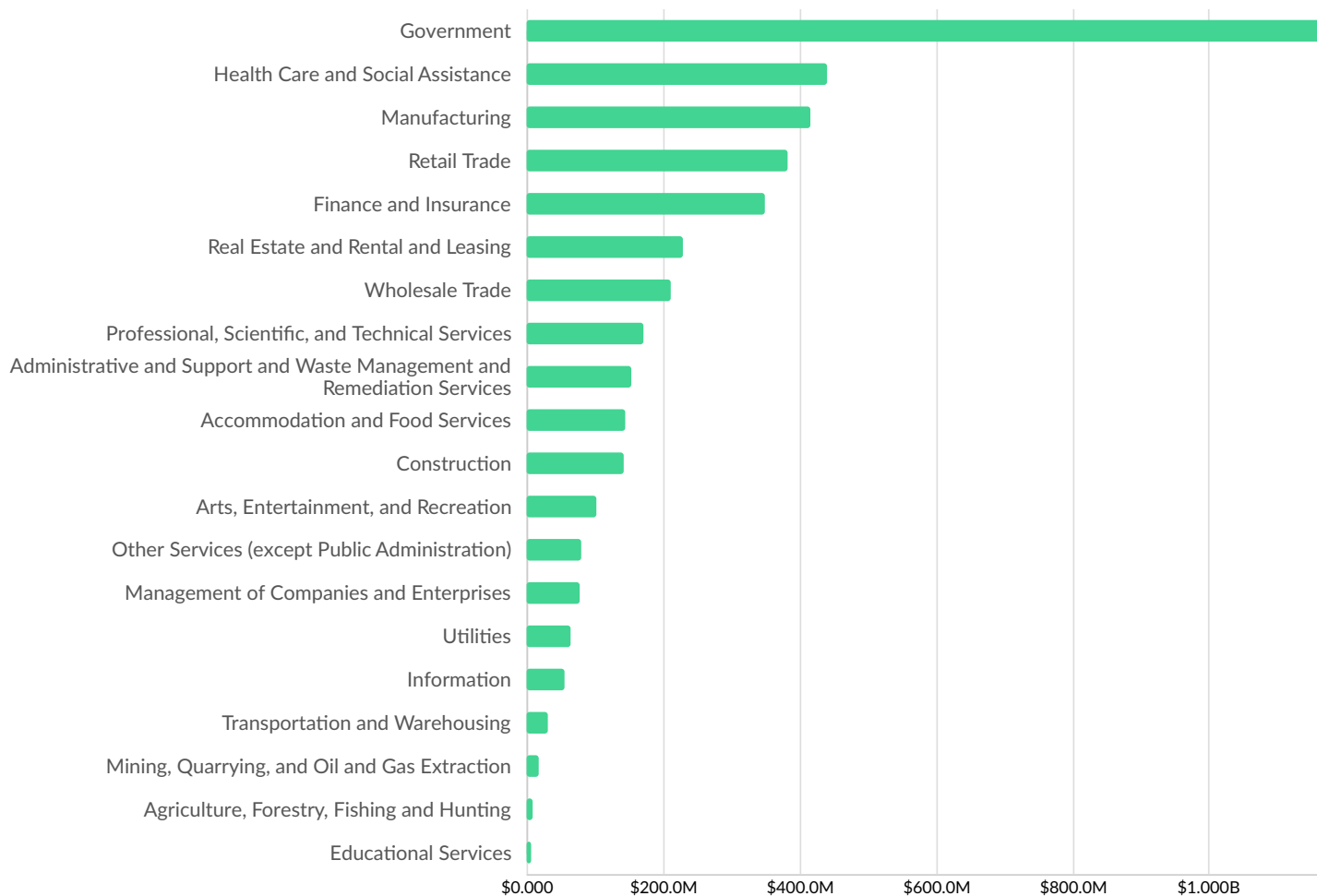
Top Industry Location Quotient

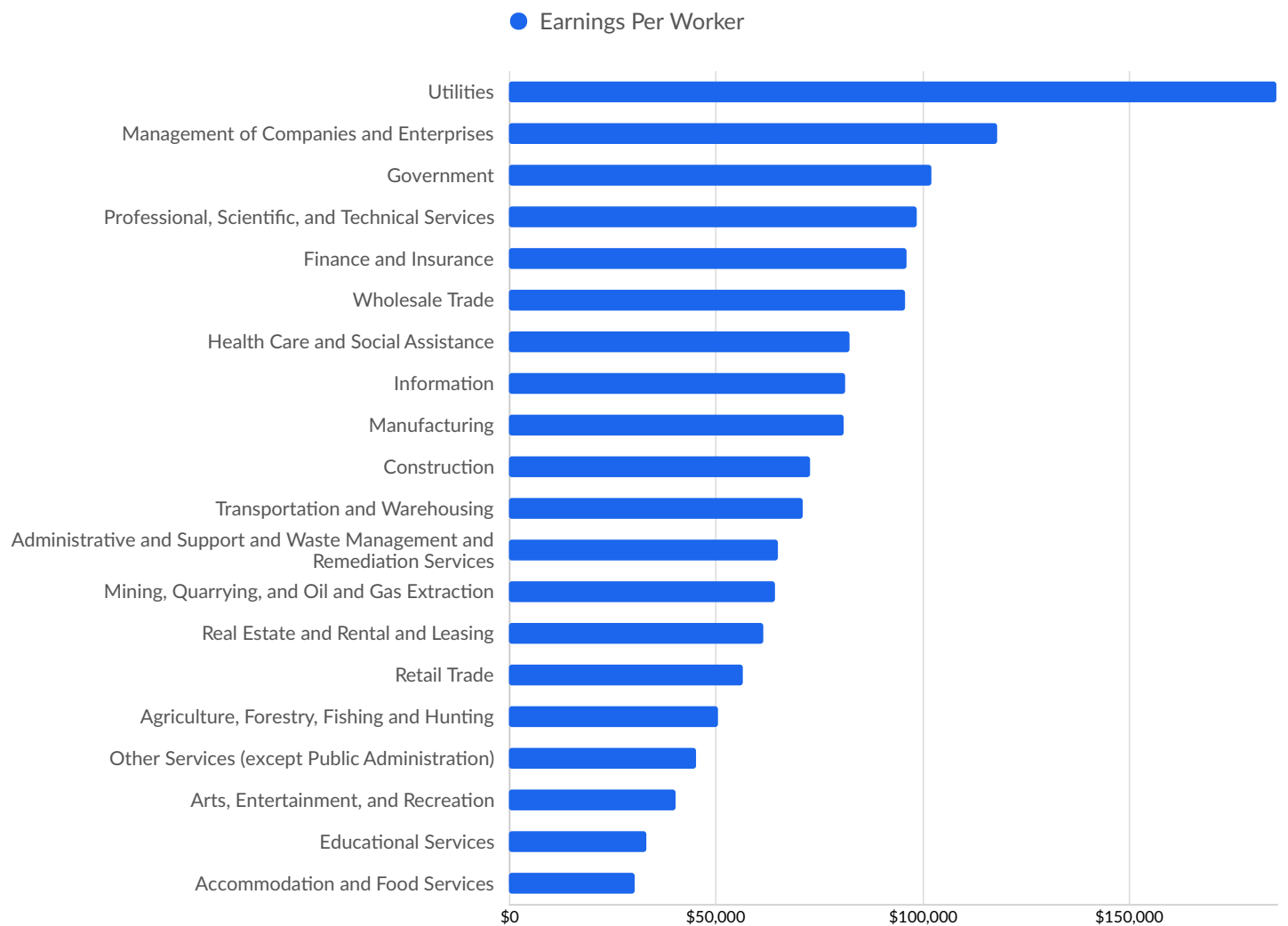


Top Industry GRP

Top Industry Earnings



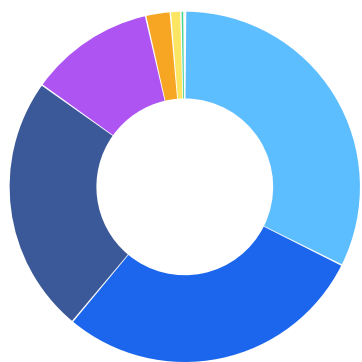

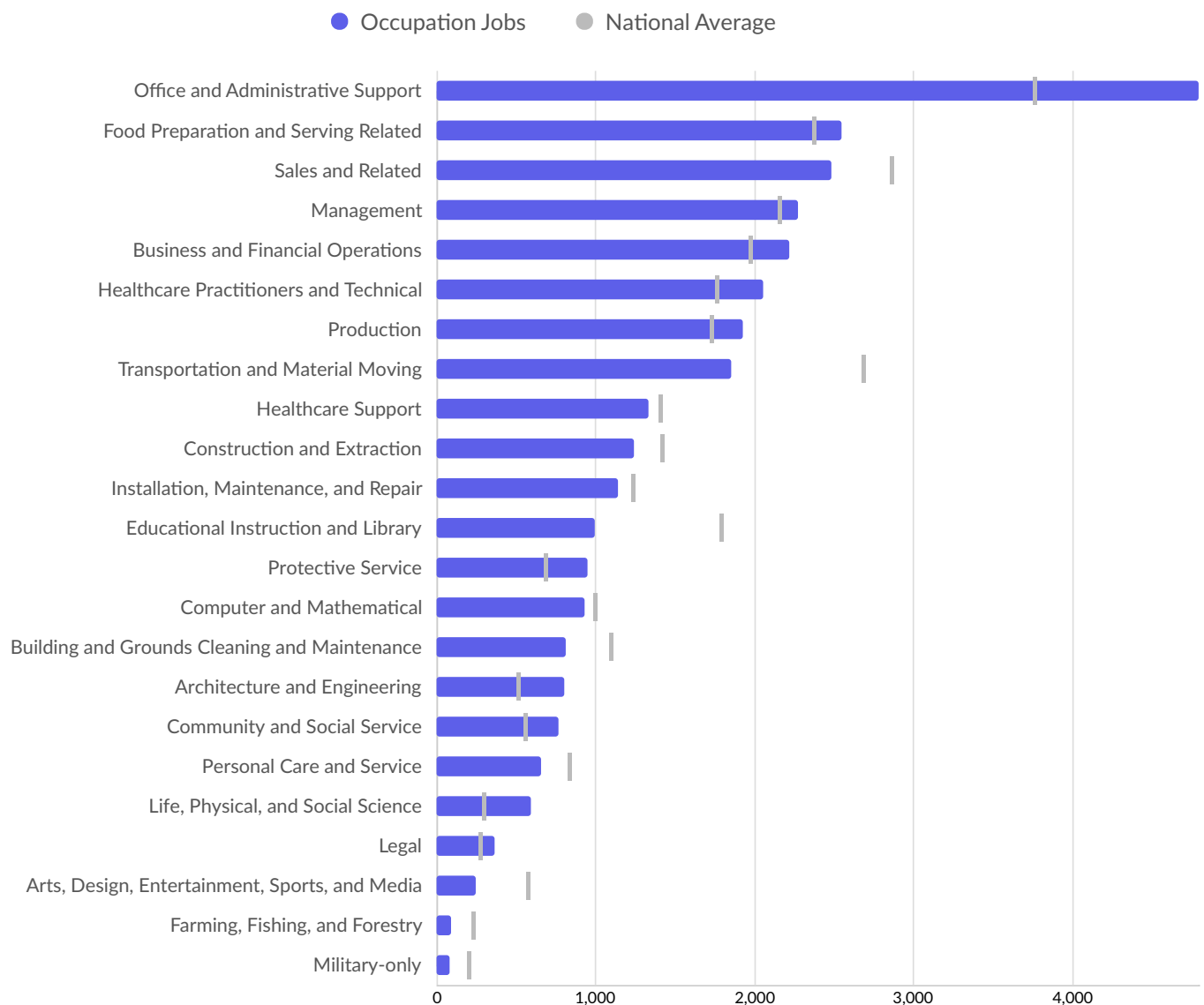

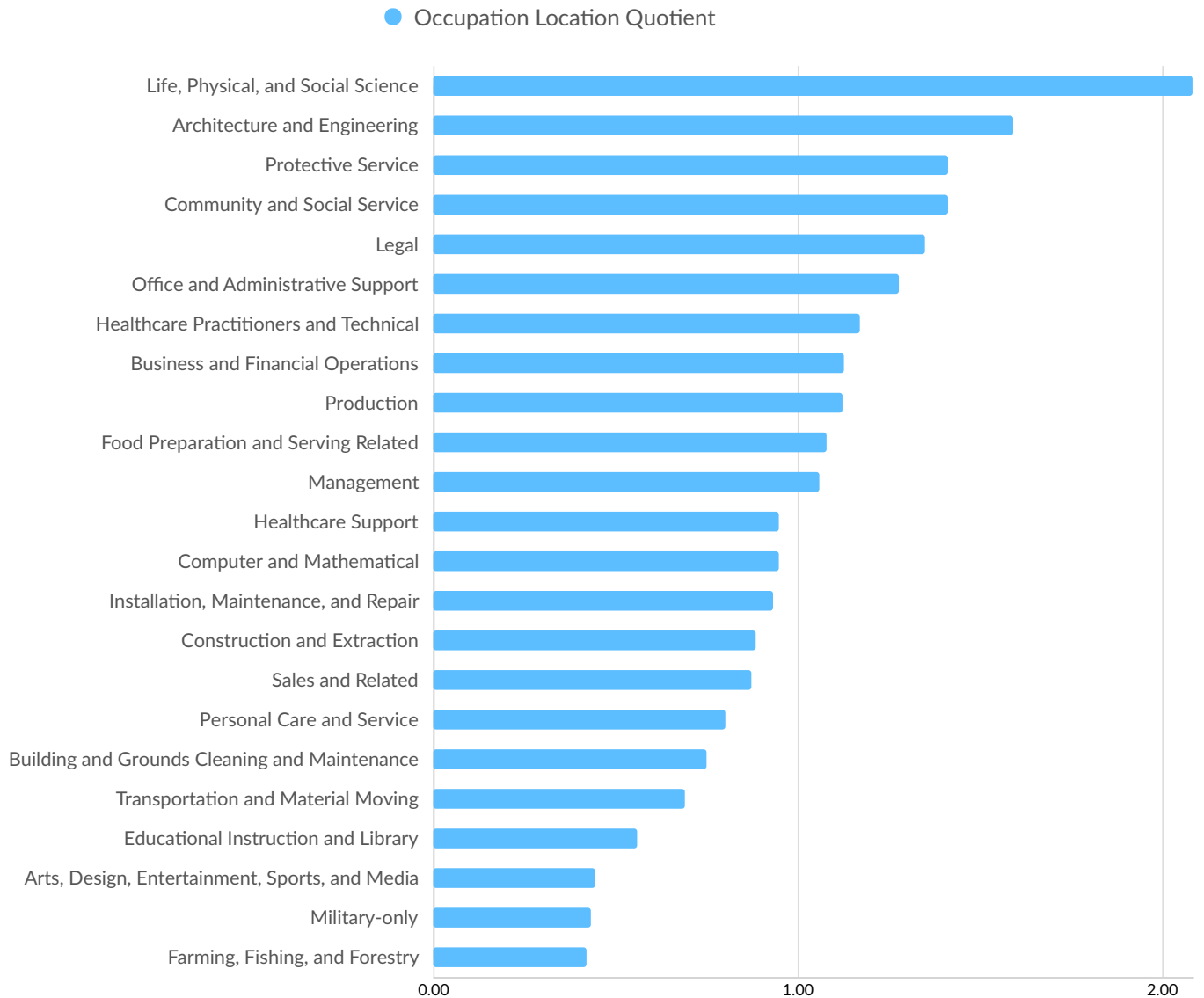
Largest Occupations



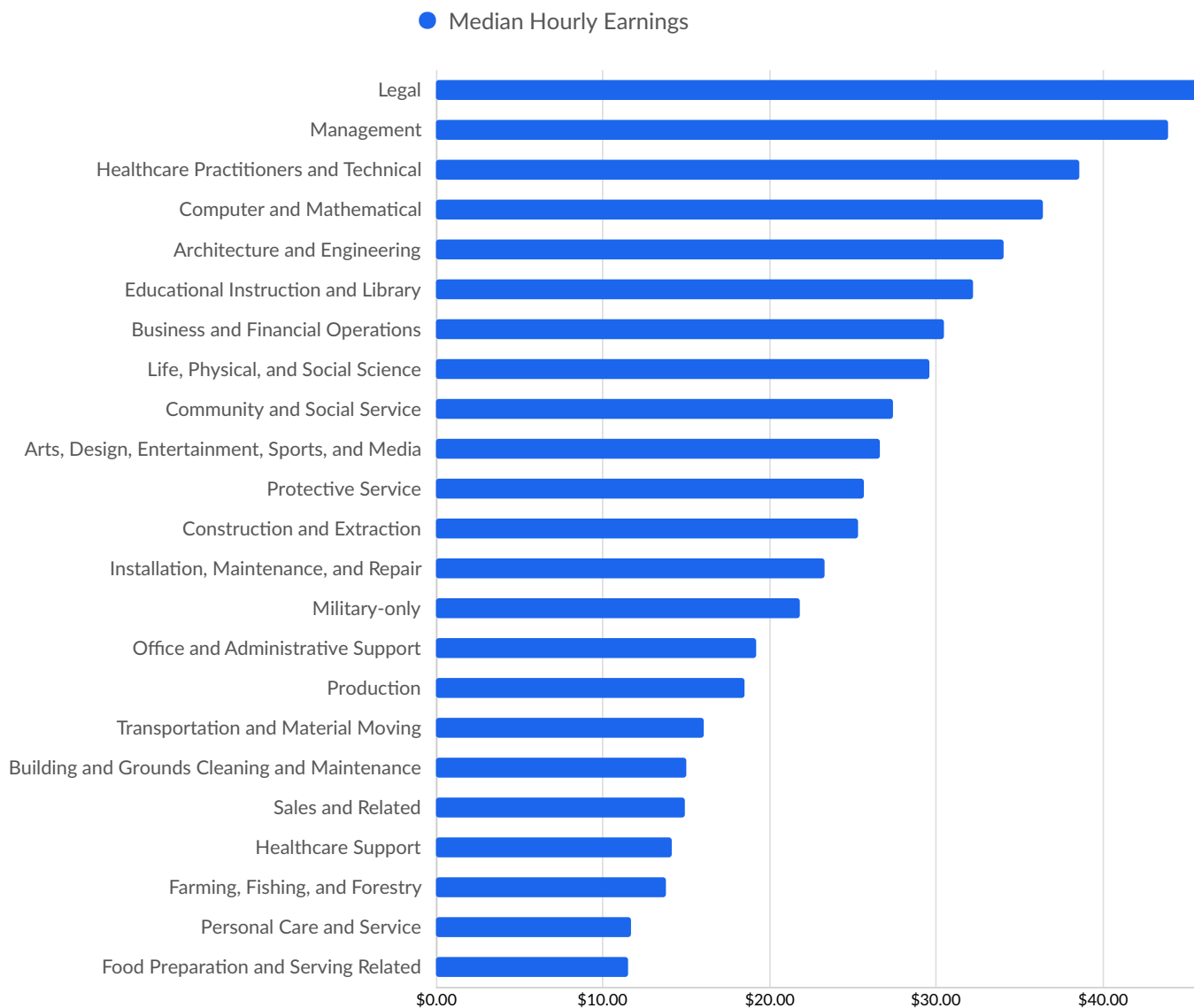
Top Growing Occupations



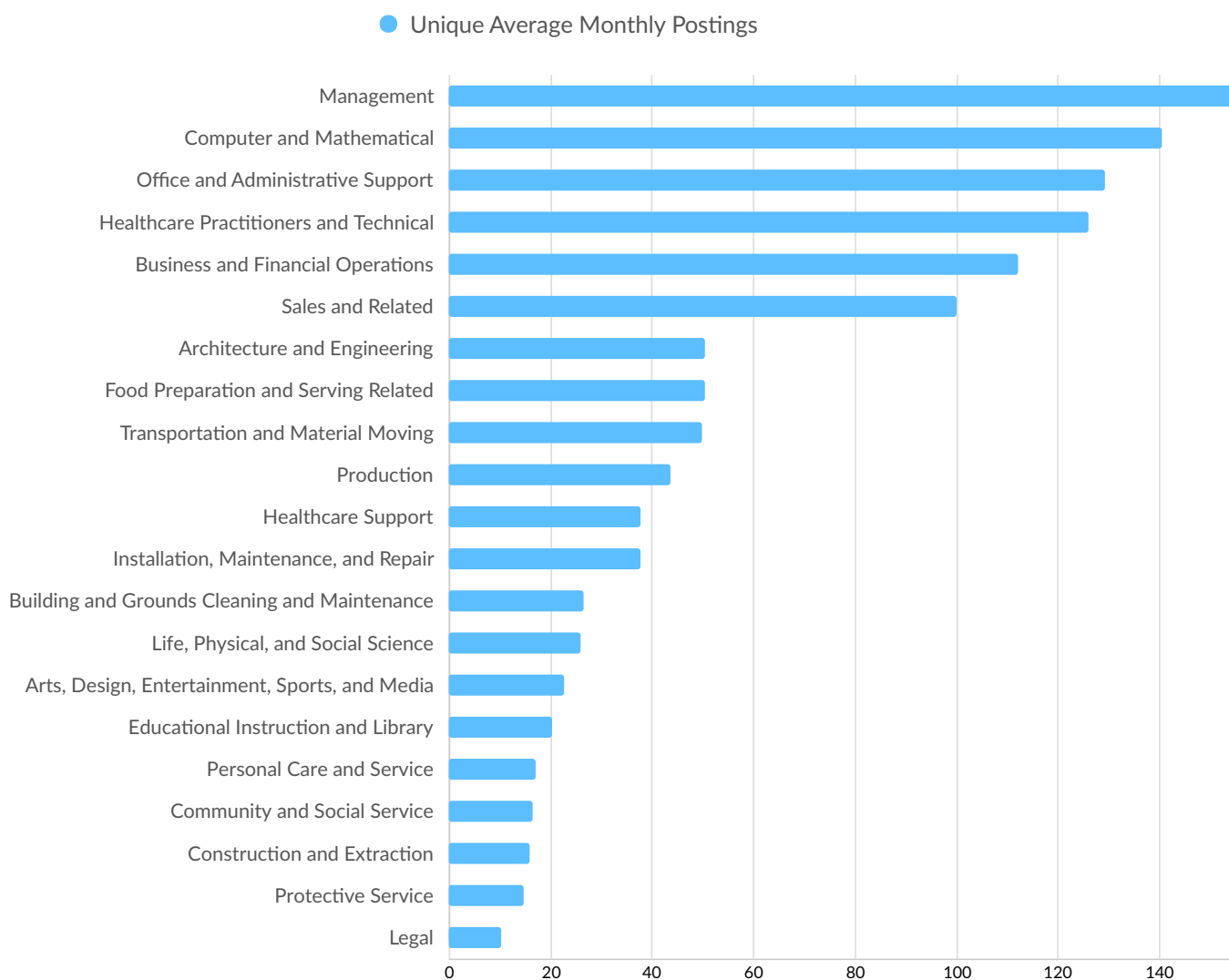
Top Occupation Location Quotient



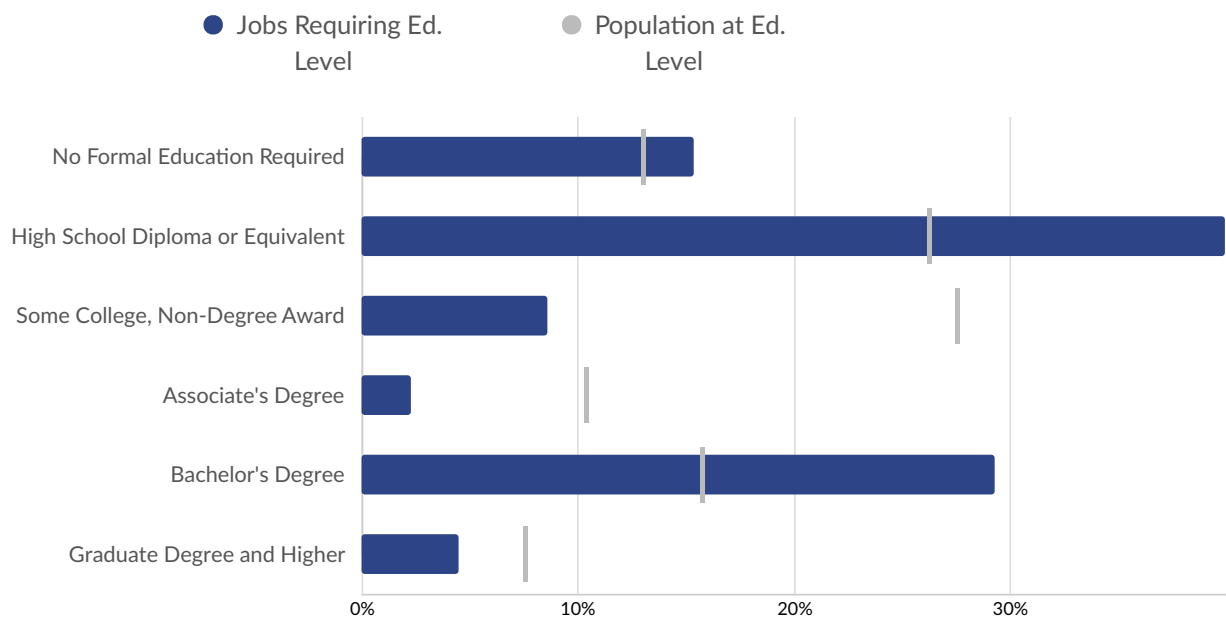
Top Occupation Earnings

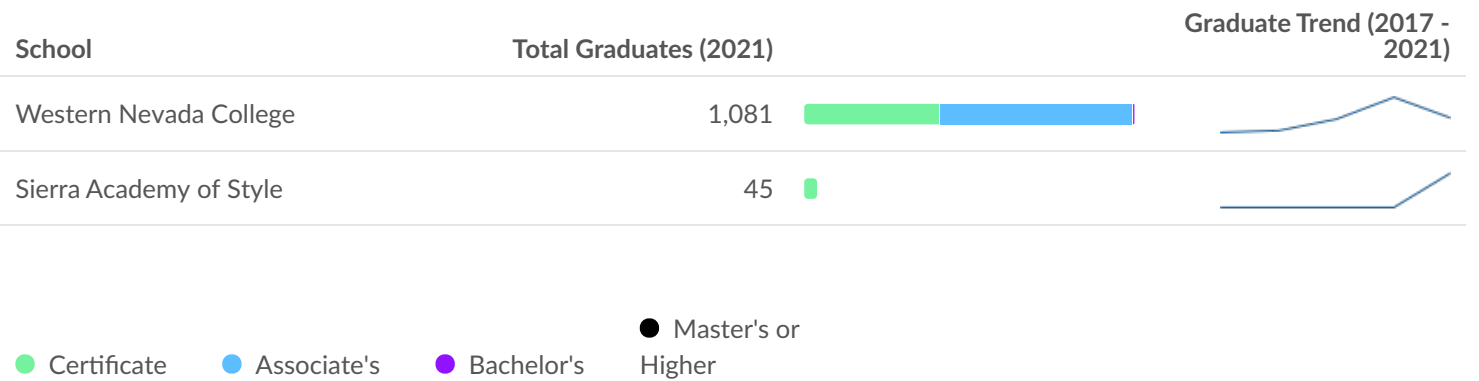

In 2021, there were 1,126 graduates in Carson City County, NV. This pipeline has grown by 22% over the last 5 years.
