
Median household income is **\$26.0K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **declined by 5.7%** in Mineral County, NV from 1,652 to **1,558**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.4% by 9.1%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 54.0% to 54.9% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **10.0% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.8% below the national average), and **4.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Facilities Support Services, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







Unemployment by Age





Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity




Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Mineral County, NV had a January 2023 unemployment rate of 5.09%, **decreasing from 5.11% 5 years before**.





Mineral County, NV has 833 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 937.


Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,363 people 55 or older, while there are 1,861 here.

Racial diversity is about average in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,866 racially diverse people, while there are 1,845 here.




Veterans

Mineral County, NV has 1.1 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Location Quotient




