The Challenge

Containers with goods stuck at the port caused late deliveries and thousands of dollars in penalty fees.

Bedding, pillows, towels, kitchen linens... everyday essentials that can be found in just about every store. But what happens when a leading worldwide textile producer and supplier to major hotels across the U.S. and a prime retailer on the biggest e-commerce website can't get their goods out of the ports quickly enough for demand? This issue was becoming a significant barrier to their operations.

The company had been relying on third-party logistics (3PL) providers to move their containers, but they encountered issues that caused containers to get stuck at the port. This was particularly problematic as items stuck at ports often incur penalties, leading to increased costs and delays.

The company realized that it needed a more efficient and reliable solution to this problem to streamline its operations and minimize financial losses.



The Solution

Rent chassis trailers using the COOP by Ryder platform to expedite the transportation of containers carrying their goods.


