We build relationships with investors and Indigenous social entrepreneurs to drive positive outcomes. We seek to address pressing social, economic, and environmental challenges, by supporting Indigenous innovators.

As an Indigenous intermediary, we honour the Seven Sacred Teachings and we operate from the perspective of an Indigenous worldview. We follow traditional Indigenous protocols, we work for the well-being of people and the planet, and we acknowledge our responsibility to the next seven generations.

The journey of Raven Indigenous Capital Partners is a story. We honour storytelling as a valid way to share our impact, and we believe stories are medicine. In doing so, we practice ceremonial protocols including smudging and gift-giving, and placing relationships, respect and reciprocity at the heart of our work. This Impact Snapshot shares some of these stories, drawn from key interviews with RICP investors, Indigenous entrepreneurs and the social finance ecosystem in Canada. While hearing these stories we were also able to understand some strategic important alignments to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and additional metrics.





We work across the ecosystem space - with investors, governments and other organizations - to help build awareness, new tools and an enabling infrastructure for Indigenous entrepreneurs to find innovative ways of addressing social and environmental issues.


