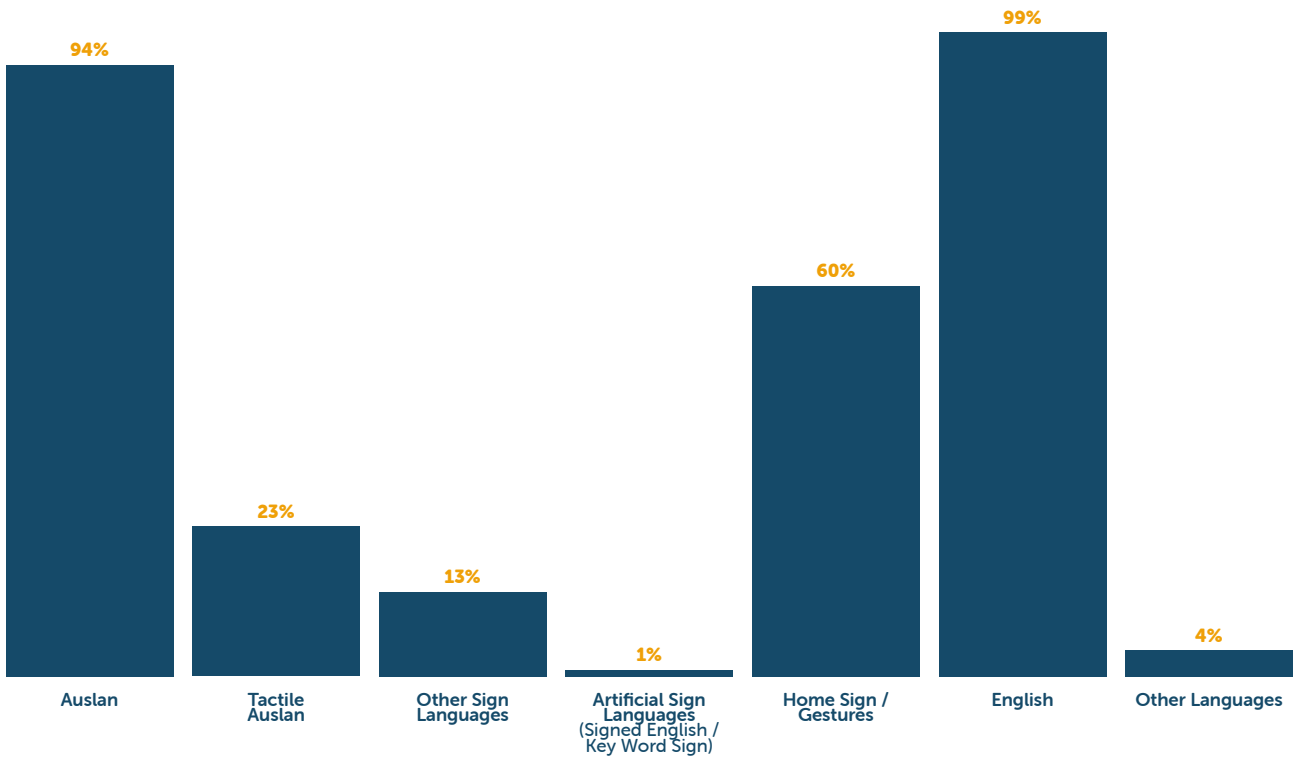

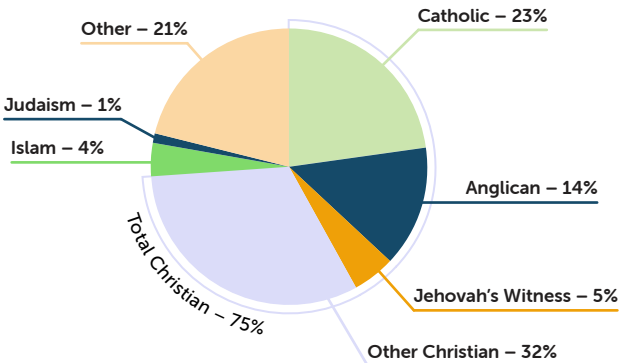


Part of a Religious Group

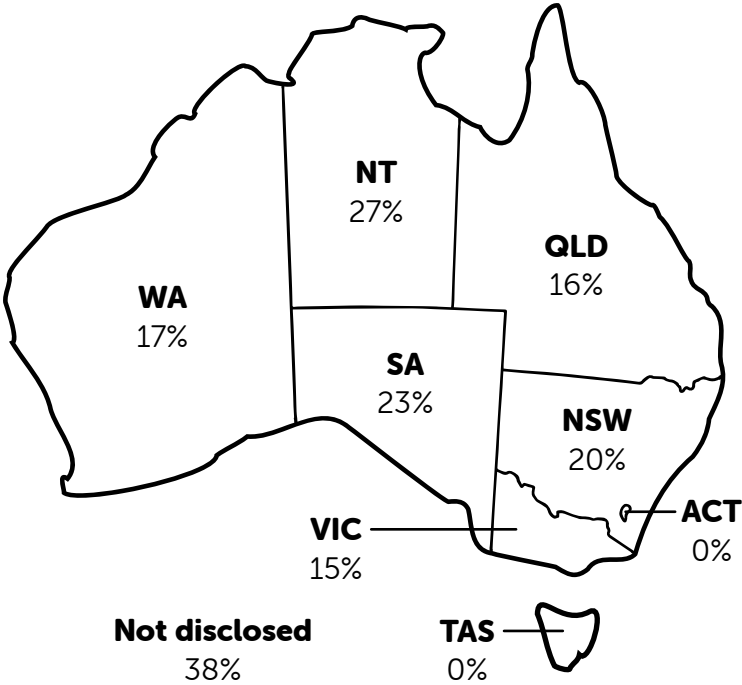
