Dr. Watson shared several recent CART activities and highlights. 17 1. C.E.O. Dr. Watson CART updates: 18 a. CART participated in the recent FUSD School Choice Expo and the CUSD Fancher Creek 19 Stem Night. Several staff and the CART Crew students Attended and had a great time talking about CART with 20 prospective students. b. At our staff meeting this month, CUSD nurses trained 21 the staff on various student medication applications and emergency situations. 22 c. CART held the annual College and Career Fair on November 1st. We had thirty plus vendors present, which included several branches of the Armed Services, 23 Law Enforcement and Emergency Personnel, Grundfos Manufacturing, and several higher education institutions. 24 d. CART has nominated this year's winner of the Noli award, Kathy Garner. Kathy is the Founder and Director of Fresno Wildlife 25 Rehabilitation and Rescue and Nature Center. Kathy has been a mentor and supporter of CART staff and students for many years. 26 We are all excited that she will be receiving this award. 27 28
