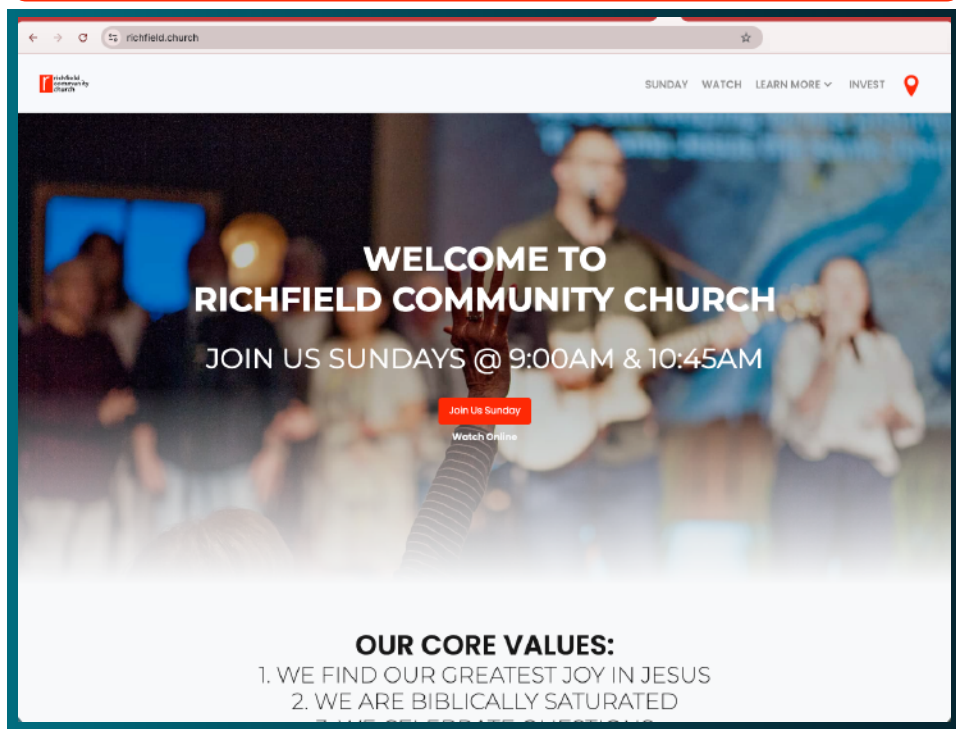

Some lessons for times of difficulty:

vv. 1-2 There may be seasons where we feel abandoned and forgotten by God—and that feeling isn't proof we've done something wrong.

vv. 1-2, 3-4 When we feel abandoned by God, God invites us to express that to Him and to ask Him for help.

vv. 5-6 In times of difficulties, we are to remind ourselves of God's love and faithfulness.
