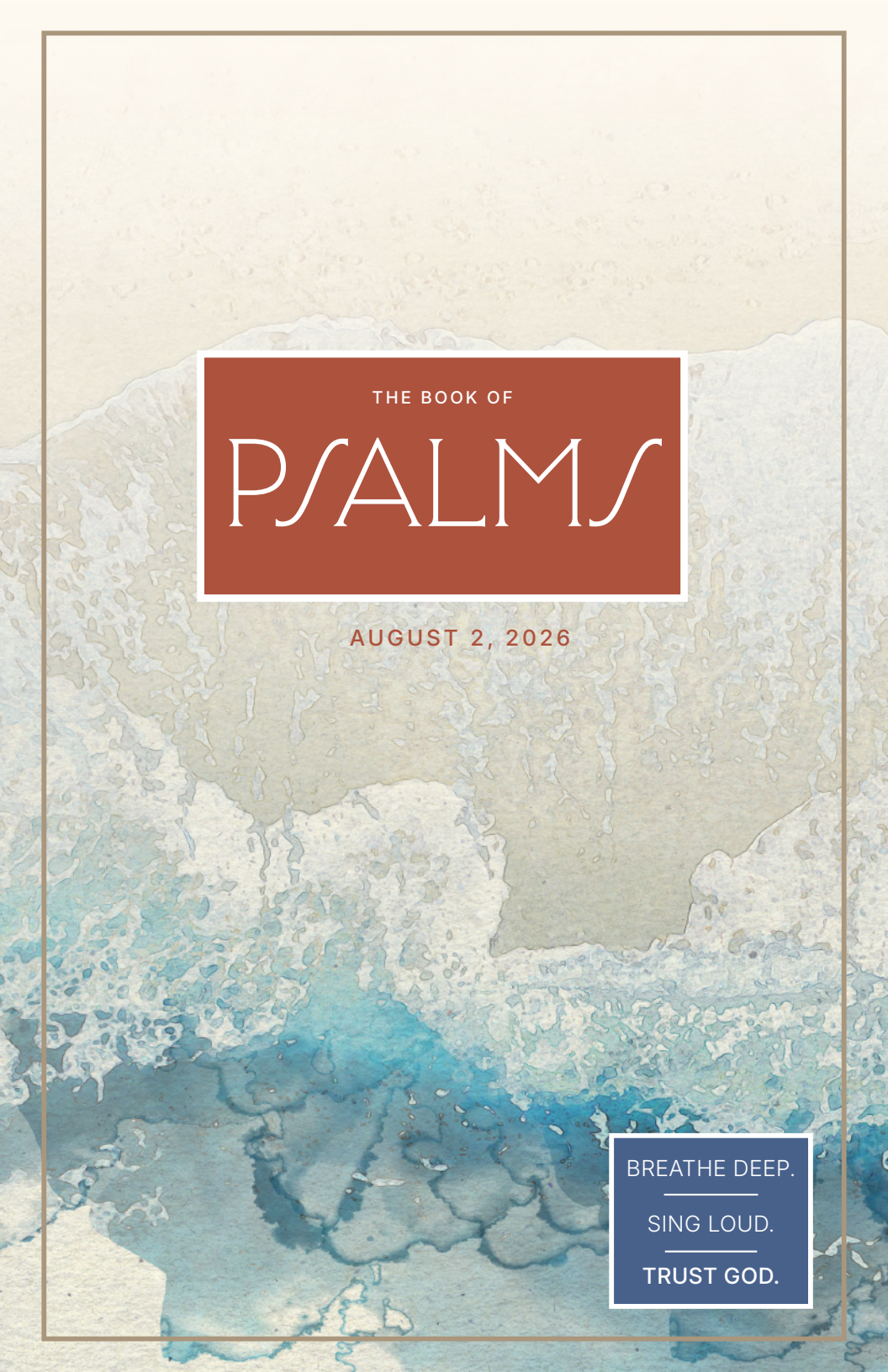

- ¹ The heavens declare the glory of God,
and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

- ⁴ Their voice goes out through all the earth,
