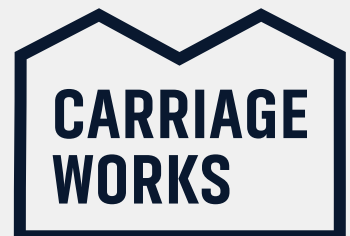

Located at the heart of the London to Bristol corridor, the Carriage Works is a series of Grade II listed industrial buildings collectively known as the Carriage Works, divided into the: West Shed, East Shed and bike sheds (London Street). Built in 1876 during the expansion of the Great Western Railway, the site is being lovingly restored to create modern spaces for business, culture, community and ideas to thrive - together. It's home for pioneers, tech innovators, creative makers and humble beginnings. It's your chance to be written into the next chapter and join our mission to build a better Swindon.

BUSINESS UNITS TAILORED TO YOUR VISION

The development is being delivered in phases, offering flexible spaces from 200m² to 2,000m². Its modular design allows layouts to be customised - from open-plan areas to double-height volumes or units with mezzanine levels, tailored to your needs and future ambitions.

From flexible shell units and creative studios to co-working desks and event spaces, the Carriage Works offers room for every stage of your journey. Plug into a thriving cluster of digital, tech, and creative businesses in a location with unrivalled rail and road links, five minutes from the town centre, and close to Swindon Designer Outlet, cafés, hotels, and cultural venues.



FLEXIBLE OFFICES DESIGNED FOR DIGITAL, TECH AND CREATIVE BUSINESSES

We have 10 offices (150–750 ft²) available with spaces designed for 4 to 15 people, and each comes with 12 free meeting room hours each month plus booking discounts. Parking is also available by advance booking or monthly permit.

Three street front spaces for independent retail/hospitality businesses are also available, with space from 160m² to 260m². More units are planned.

Workshed is ideal for flexibility and convenience - whether you want to hot desk, a designated desk or an office you'll be able to upscale, downsize, take on more space or even end your contract easily and without fuss. BRUNEL BRINGS THE RAILWAY TO SWINDON

Founded in 1868, Swindon Carriage Works expanded across 137 acres to become Britain's largest carriage works. Under Joseph Armstrong's leadership, the site grew not only in scale but also in social innovation - it was among the first GWR works to employ women, starting with the upholstery and polishing departments in the early 1870s. From timber-built carriages to pioneering engineering, the legacy of craft, scale and progress still drives today's creators and businesses.



2018

REGENERATION BEGINS WITH WORKSHED

In 2018, regeneration of Swindon's Carriage Works started with the opening of the Workshed - a bold new workspace carved out of heritage industrial sheds. Designed as an incubator with offices and co-working space for digital, tech and creative businesses, it set the tone for the wider redevelopment, proving how historic architecture could be reimagined as a home for modern innovation and Swindon's thriving business community.



2019-2024

CREATE STUDIOS, RAU CULTURAL HERITAGE INSTITUTE, ICAST OPEN

Between 2019 and 2024, the Carriage Works regeneration gathered pace. Award-winning Create Studios established a new film and media hub, the Royal Agricultural University's Cultural Heritage Institute brought research and teaching into the heart of the site, and ICAST, a joint venture from Bath and Oxford universities, opened to pioneer sustainable technologies - strengthening the campus as a centre for innovation.



2025

THE CURRENT PHASE DELIVERING MORE OFFICE OR EDUCATIONAL SPACE

Construction on Phase Three began in February 2025, delivering 2,000m² of new office space over the next 12 months. The shell and core build includes major structural upgrades, modern insulation, double glazing and essential facilities - preparing flexible, listed-building approved spaces for creative, tech and digital businesses to move in and make their own.



2026+

THE NEXT PHASE EXPANDING THE VISION

We are actively seeking suitable occupiers for fit out of the space. With further development of the remaining 500m2 of West Shed space planned.

Built by Brunel's Great Western Railway in the 19th century, the Carriage Works once powered the world's largest railway works. Today, this iconic site has been regenerated into a modern business hub that's home to organisations spanning creativity, technology, and education. Managed by Swindon Borough Council in partnership with anchor institutions, our mission is clear: protect the heritage, fuel the future, and provide flexible offices for innovative businesses along the London to Bristol corridor.

FACTS AND STATS

Carriage Works has an expanding business community. With 1000+ active members, not all on site at once, but this membership offers a constant flow of activity and interactions that make the Carriage Works a hub of innovation.

Swindon offers housing affordability with house prices lower than regional and national averages. This makes it a great place in the middle of the South of England to get on the property ladder. Great for attracting young talent to your company.

Productivity in Swindon is high compared to both Regional and National Comparisons. GDP per head (2023) £57,253 is significantly higher than both regional and national comparison. National GDP per head (2023) £33k and South West (2023) £37k.

OUR VISION: BUILDING A BETTER SWINDON

The regeneration of the Carriage Works is part of a bold, town-wide mission to reimagine Swindon's heart. What began with the restoration of its historic railway sheds has grown into a catalyst for change, linking with major initiatives across the centre.

To the west, **The Works** (formerly the Heritage Action Zone) is breathing new life into Brunel's Railway Village, Health Hydro and surrounding landmarks. It's a celebration of history and culture, creating a vibrant neighbourhood where heritage, knowledge and big ideas come together.

At the same time, the **Heart of Swindon** vision is reshaping the town centre into a fairer, greener and more creative place to live, work and spend time. New homes, cultural venues, public spaces and independent businesses are central to its ambition.

Anchoring it all is **Knowledge Central**, one of the UK's most significant new innovation hubs. Positioned at the station gateway, it connects world-class research, sustainable technologies and high-growth companies with Swindon's strong tradition of making and doing.

Together, these initiatives form a joined-up approach: protecting Swindon's heritage, boosting opportunity, and ensuring **Carriage Works** sits at the centre of a better, more connected future for the town.

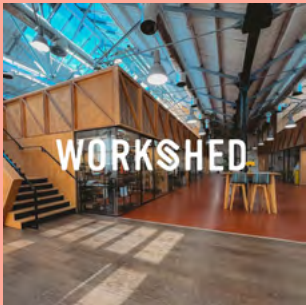
COMMUNAL BREAKOUT AREAS FOR COLLABORATION

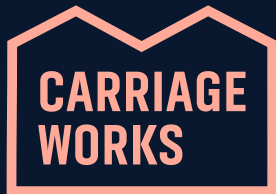
