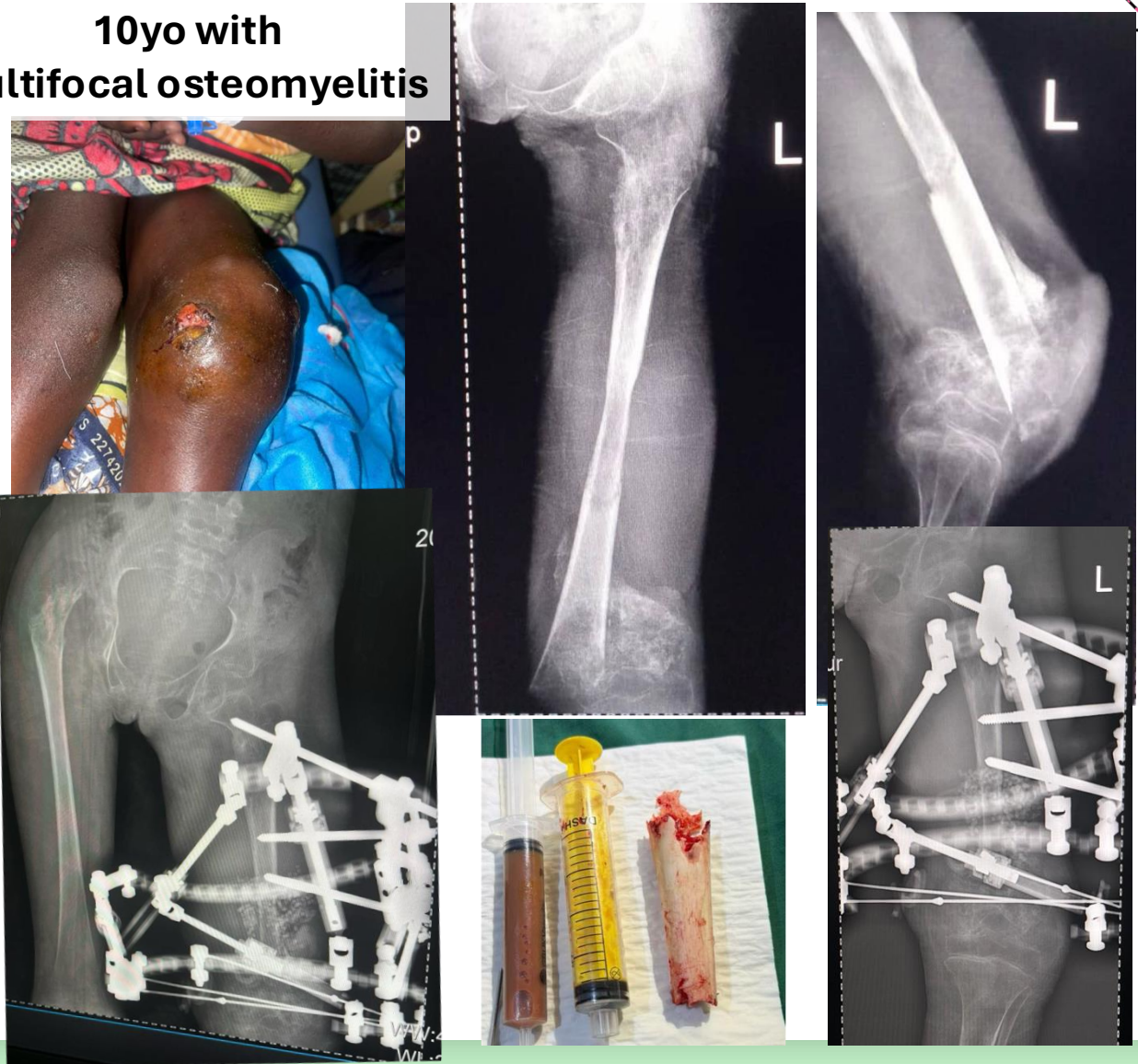

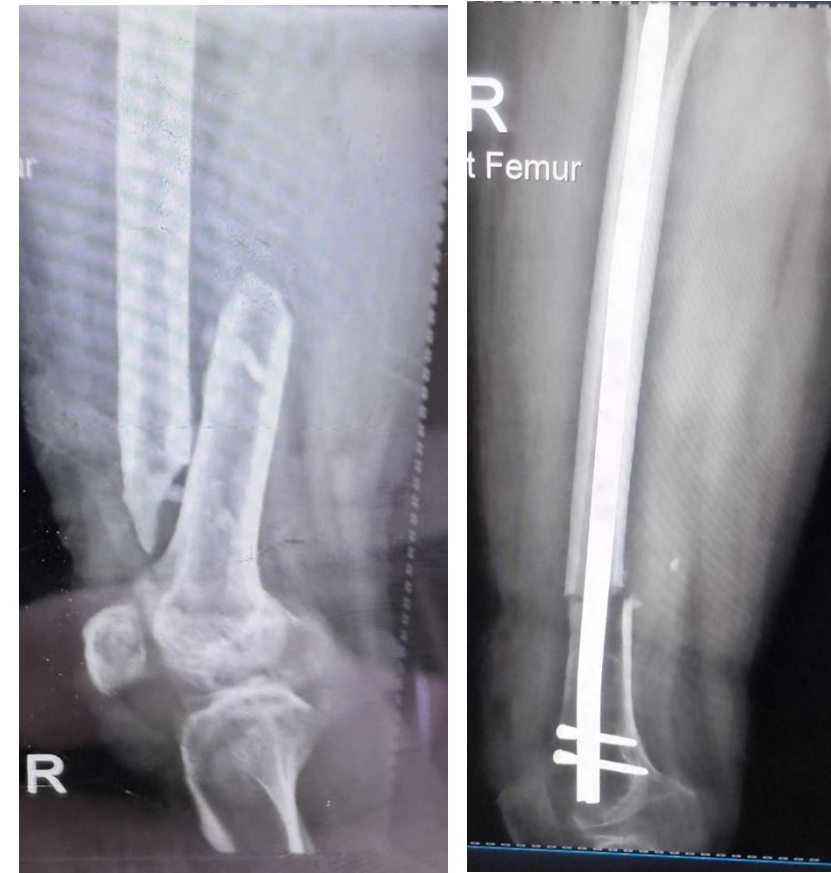

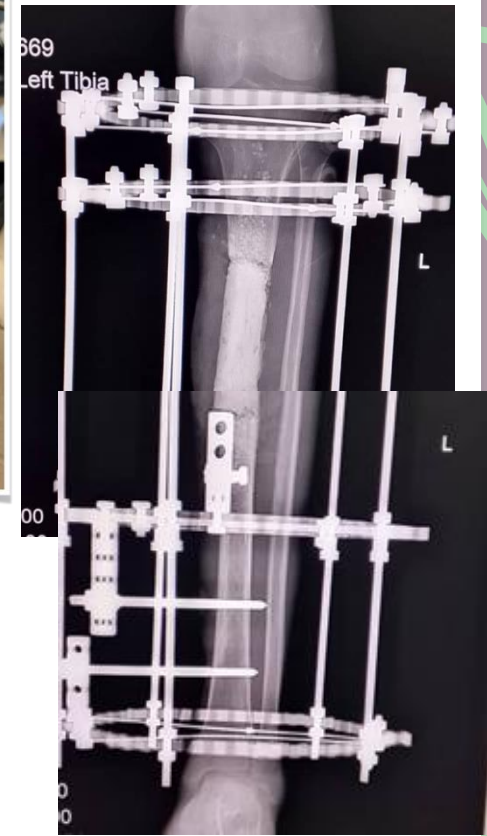

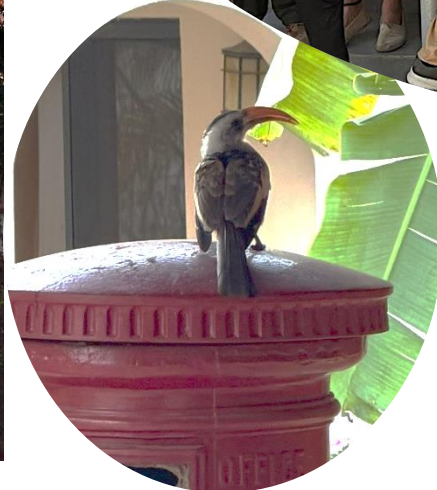


7y – Axillary burn contracture release
