As a direct result of the above incidents and the increasing trend to mishandle these auxiliary vehicles, we are initiating the measures below. Our goal is simple: avoid further injury and property damage and help ensure the safety of all our guests. Please understand, we could have eliminated all auxiliary motorized vehicles in their entirety. We did not. However, do recognize this is a trial program.
