Summit Motorsports Park Code of Conduct

Thank you for coming to **Summit Motorsports Park**! This Summit Motorsports Park 'Code of Conduct' has been established to help create a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable experience for all our guests – of every age. Guests are required to take responsibility for their behavior in order to insure they are not interfering with the enjoyment of others. Guests are specifically required to refrain from the following:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature
- Intoxication or other signs of impairment that result in offensive and/or irresponsible behavior.
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures
- Interference with the event
- Failure to follow instructions of stadium personnel or law enforcement.
- Verbal or physical harassment of others including all fans, participants, officials and staff.
- Smoking in the seating bowl
- Theft or vandalism
- Engaging in any of the above code violations in any areas outside **Summit Motorsports Park** that are owned or operated by **Summit Motorsports Park** or its affiliates.

All ticket holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests or any other people they allow to use their seats. Event patrons and/or guests who violate these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund, and risk potential loss of ticket privileges for future shows.

EVENT DAY TEXT MESSAGING SERVICE: Text (419) 554-0550 to report incidents anonymously.

Summit Motorsports Park accepts text messages as an anonymous method of reporting conduct and behavioral issues. If the behavior of a guest or guests around you becomes disruptive or violates this Guest Code of Conduct, call or text (419) 554-0550, giving your *EXACT* location followed by a detailed description of the issue. (If you are in the seating bowl, provide grandstand name, section number, row, and seat number as well as a general description of the offender).

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How may I contact the track?

A: Our regular phone is (419) 668-5555 available during regular office hours and while open during events. During events, our texting line will be available 24/7 for inquiry or reporting problems/guest issues. Please text (419) 554-0550.

Q: Do you have an ATM?

A: An ATM is available at Guest Services.

Q: How may I secure my canopies or etc in the pits?

A: There is absolutely NO STAKING allowed in the asphalt. We do provide concrete buckets with hooks to help you secure your canopies, tents, or etc. These are located on the Pit side between Dornan's Part Shop and Golf Cart Rental buildings and are available on a first come first serve basis at no cost. Please return when finished.

Q: Where may I dispose of waste oil?

A: There is a large barrel for waste oil in the yellow Safety Kleen shed near Dornan's (along the 601 fence on the Pit side) as well as in the SE corner of family camping on the Summit Side.

Q: Do you provide a dump station or somewhere I can dispose of grey water?

A: We do not have an onsite dump station and do not permit any emptying or disposal onsite but have a dump truck from Kurtzman's Sanitation that will come during events to service guests. Please check the event schedule for when we are expecting them, and flag them down when you see them. Their rate is \$35 for each service. We have a list of area dump stations as well.

Q: Do you have a water fill station onsite?

A: While we do not have a place to fill onsite, we do have an outside water hauling company that comes in for most events and you may pay directly. Please check with the office or guest services for event specific information. You may leave your name, phone number, and location with the nearest gate staff and they will give the list to them so they stop by your site.

Q: Where do I collect payout?

A: Summit Motorsports Park issues payout from Guest Services. Some event promoters handle their own payout- you can check with your event coordinator or stop in at Guest Services for direction.

Q: Do you sell ice?

A: Yes, ice is available at the permanent concession buildings.

Q: May I or my friends park overnight in the general parking lot?

A: Vehicles may be left in the general parking lots overnight, however, camping/sleeping overnight in the parking lots is not permitted per State code.

Q: Do you have showers on site?

A: Showers are located in the restrooms behind the Ohio CAT grandstands with hours posted on the doors, and the Shower Tickets may be purchased at the Throttle Town Grille. For guests camping on the Summit Side during the NHRA Nationals, please see the Summit Gate or your camping managers for shower tickets.

Q: May we bring in a golf cart/ATV/etc?

A: The NHRA does not permit use during their NHRA Nationals event, with exception to those with handicap credentials. They will check the registration and I.D. at the gate, then issue a handicap sticker for the golf cart for the event.

For most other events (as currently standing) the use of golf carts is permitted so long as the regulations are followed:

1. Only guests with a valid driver's license are permitted to operate a motorized vehicle.
2. Guests operating a motorized vehicle are expected to follow a posted maximum speed limit of 10 miles-per-hour.
3. Guests under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not permitted to operate a motorized vehicle.
4. High speeds, or dangerous/reckless behavior when operating a motorized vehicle is prohibited.

Please see website for full information on motorized vehicle usage at the Park.

Q: May I rent a golf cart onsite?

A: For most events except NHRA, golf cart rentals are available. Call Dornan's at (419) 912-4028 to reserve, or while onsite during events call (419) 663-2254 to reach them at the Track.

Q: May I bring in food and drinks?

A: Yes, food and beverages are welcome, but no alcohol or glass.

Q: How do I coordinate a catered meal for my race team?

A: If you would like to coordinate services, please contact Bobbie Bader in advance at (419) 668-5555 ext. 111.

Q: May I bring alcohol in?

A: If you are camping, alcohol may be consumed responsibly on your site, but outside alcohol is not permitted to be brought outside of your area.

Q: Do you have food vendors onsite?

A: We have a permanent concession stand called the Throttle Town Grille, which is located behind the Ohio CAT side grandstands and open for all events. For many events, we also open our Summit side concessions and bring in outside vendors.

Q: Are coolers permitted?

A: Coolers are permitted at campsites and pit spaces. If you bring them into the Park, please limit them to no larger than 14" any dimension.

Q: Are backpacks permitted?

A: Backpacks are permitted, please use a regular or mini size inside the Park, nothing extra large.

Q: Are strollers/wagons for children permitted?

A: Strollers and small wagons for children may be used on premises, but they may not be brought into the grandstands. You may park them underneath the grandstands when you go to your seats but will be doing so at your own risk. Summit Motorsports Park is not liable for lost or stolen property on site.

Q: May we bring our own stadium seat for use in the grandstands?

A: Yes, including those with backs. Please limit the dimensions to no larger than 18” any dimension, and refrain from encroaching on the space of those around you.

Q: Do you sell admission at the gate?

A: Assuming there are still tickets available, you will be able to purchase at the gate. Some events, like the Night Under Fire, may sell out in advance. Please call the office or check online for availability before making your trip out.

Q: Do you have a Lost & Found?

A: During events, items found may be turned into Guest Services or (if open) the Corporate Office. All found items are moved to the Office at the end of the event. To inquire, you may call our main number, or stop in at a Guest Service location and we will find out if any location has the item.

Q: May we bring lawn chairs?

A: Lawn chairs may be used at your camping site but may not be brought into the track area.

Q: Do you provide Wi-Fi?

A: We do not have public Wi-Fi available onsite.

Summit Motorsports Park Motorhome/Camping Rules



Thank you for being our guest at Summit Motorsports Park! Our 'Code of Conduct' has been established to help create a safe, comfortable, and enjoyable experience for our guests of all ages. Guests are required to take responsibility for their behaviour to insure they are not interfering with the enjoyment of others. For complete information please visit www.summitmotorsportspark.com.

To report issues, or for assistance during office hours our landline is (419) 668-5555.

For 24/7 assistance or to submit an anonymous report during an event please text (419) 554-0550.

Summit Racing Equipment NHRA Nationals ONLY:

Golf carts and self-powered bicycles are restricted to handicapped guests within the park. Must present handicap registration and photo I.D. at gate.

All Events Other Than The Summit Racing Equipment NHRA Nationals

Except for golf carts and handicapped scooters, spectators may not bring *any other* auxiliary motorized vehicles onto Summit Motorsports Park grounds. This includes but is not limited to: (1) side-by-sides, (2) quads, (3) 3-wheelers, (4) 4-wheelers, (5) mini-bikes, (6) dirt bikes, (7) hover boards, (8) electric bicycles, (9) or other personal motorized vehicles.

General Motorhome/Camping Rules

All generators MUST be properly vented away from neighboring guests and neighboring guest units per the State of Ohio rules and regulations.

1. The speed limit across all Summit Motorsport's Property is 10 miles per hour. All motor vehicle operators must have a valid state driver's license.
2. One motor vehicle or two motorcycles are permitted to park in your camping site. Golf carts count as one.
3. The owner of the Camping/Motorhome site will be responsible for all members of his/her party.
4. After 1:00 am any noise complaints from neighbors in all camping/motorhome areas are grounds for immediate removal. Exception: Family Camping quiet hours are between 11:00 pm – 7:00 am.
5. To gain access to a Camping/Motorhome site; you must have a Camping/Motorhome placard, a camping ticket and full event admission tickets for each camper. Only full event ticket holders will be permitted on the Trackside Motorhome, Wilson's Fence Row, Wilson's Overflow, Piston Park, or Family Camping sites after racing is completed.
6. Campfires are permitted in fire rings only; no open burning is permitted. Guests provide their own fire ring.
7. You are expected to leave your site as clean as you found it.
8. All roadways and walkways must be kept clear.
9. Arrival and departure times must be observed. Please refer to the website for specific move-in hours for a particular event.
10. Alcohol may be consumed responsibly on your site but is not permitted to be brought into the grandstands or race areas.
11. Illegal activities or activities that violate local laws and Camping/Motorhome rules or Health Department rules are not permitted. Lewd behavior, offensive signs, public intoxication and/or profanity will not be tolerated. Violators will be arrested and removed from the facility as well as forfeiting all renewal rights. NO REFUNDS!
12. Pets are welcome but must be kept on a leash and must not be a nuisance to other guests. Pet Registration forms should be completed and given to the area Camping Manager. Only service animals are permitted in the grandstands. Please clean up after your pet.
13. No glass containers of any kind are permitted on the grounds.
14. No fireworks of any kind are permitted on the grounds.
15. The Summit Motorsports Park Campground/Motorhome Manager may exercise his/her discretion in the enforcement and application of these rules.
16. All RV's, travel trailers, tents and pop-ups must allow no less than 10 feet between units end to end and 15 feet between unit's side to side per the Ohio Health Department of Campgrounds.

Facility Regulations

1. Asphalt – It is not permitted to penetrate our asphalt with anything, including nails, spikes, and stakes.
2. Electrical Boxes – Do not tamper with the boxes/break the tag to gain access to the box.
3. Oil Disposal – Properly dispose your oil, filters, etc.
4. Hot Coal Disposal – Properly cool hot items prior to disposing them. This includes coal, ashes, and cigarettes.
5. Wastewater – Dumping wastewater onto the park grounds is not permitted.

Family Campground Rules

1. We permit the following recreational vehicle types in our primitive Family Camping areas: (a) Truck campers (loaded into the bed of a pick-up truck), (b) Pop-up Trailers (also known as tent or folding camping trailers) and (c) Tents. No hard-sided campers are permitted. Hybrid campers with canvas pull outs will be permitted only on sites 2051-2060 if they conform to Ohio Health Dept. of Campgrounds distance requirements and fit on the site.
2. Up to three (3) tents are permitted per site if they comply with distance requirements by the Ohio Health Department of Campgrounds.
3. One passenger vehicle or two motorcycles are permitted per campsite; extra vehicles must park in spectator parking.
4. The Family Campground includes families with children, and everyone is required to behave accordingly.
5. Quiet hours will be strictly enforced between 11:00 pm and 7:00 am. Violators will be removed.
6. No generators are permitted in the Family Camping area.

Trackside Motorhome Rules

1. Trackside Electric and Non-electric Motorhome Camping: [Recreational vehicles are permitted including Class A, B, & C, Travel Trailers, Fifth Wheels, Sport Utility or Toy Haulers with commercially built-in living quarters only and Truck Campers.](#)
2. Our Trackside Electric Motorhome sites come with 50-amp power service. Please plan accordingly if you need an adapter, as we only have a very limited supply of adapters for sale. Trackside Electric requires you to have the proper electrical cords and adapters in the correct configuration. All 50 amp/60amp campers and motorhome units must have 50A extension cords directly from the unit to the electrical box. No other configuration is permitted.
3. No additional trailers are permitted on the campsite; this includes trailers to haul a golf cart or grills, etc.
4. Motorhomes should be parked either pulled or backed in and centered on the designated motorhome number.
5. One framed, properly secured canopy is permitted on the motorhome site in addition to attached awnings.

Wilson's Fence Row Rules

1. All units permitted in the Family Campground/Trackside Motorhome are permitted in Wilson's Fence Row. **Additionally, open and enclosed trailers are permitted in this section; however, they must reasonably fit on a 20' x 70' site.**
2. Up to three (3) tents are permitted per site if they comply with distance requirements by the Ohio Health Department of Campgrounds.

Piston Park Rules

1. Recreational vehicles are permitted including Class A, B, & C, Travel Trailers, Fifth Wheels, Sport Utility or toy Haulers with commercially built-in living quarters only and Truck Campers.
2. No additional trailers are permitted on the campsite; this includes trailers to haul a golf cart or grills, etc.
3. Motorhomes should be parked either pulled or backed in and centered on the designated motorhome number.
4. One framed, properly secured canopy is permitted on the motorhome site in addition to attached awnings.

Permitted Camping Units by Camping Area



The **Class A Motorhome** is the largest and most luxurious of the motorized RVs. Built on a specially designed chassis, the Class A is well equipped for short trips or long vacations and is also well suited for full-timers.

Permitted in: Trackside Electric and Non-Electric, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.



The **Class C (mini) Motorhome** provides many of the luxuries and conveniences of a Class A Motorhome in a scaled-down and less expensive unit. They are built on an automotive van chassis designed expressly for the Class C.

Permitted in: Trackside Electric and Non-Electric, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.



Travel Trailers are a non-motorized RV designed to be towed by a pickup truck, SUV, or (size dependent) car. These units offer all of the amenities of home. Depending on the model and floorplan, some units can sleep up to 10 people, which makes them ideal for larger families.

Permitted in: Trackside Electric and Non-Electric, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.



The **Fifth Wheel** offers maximum living space for a given trailer length. With the master bedroom over the truck bed, these units, "Fivers" as they are sometimes called, have pretty much become the RV of choice for full timers.

Permitted in: Trackside Electric and Non-Electric, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.



The **Sport Utility Trailer, or Toy Hauler** as it is more commonly known, is the newest RV on the block. With space for your motorcycles, ATVs, personal watercraft and the like, it offers the convenience and must be commercial built living quarters with the ability to haul your "toys", all in one unit.

Permitted in: Trackside Electric and Non-Electric, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.

Permitted Camping Units by Camping Area



The **Truck Camper** is loaded onto the bed of a pickup truck and is very popular for remote location camping. Some newer units even have a slide-out for increased living space. Truck Campers are ideal units for those who already own a truck, making the transition to the world of RVing much easier.

Permitted in: Traskside Electric and Non-Electric (no canvas), Family, Wilson's Fence Row, Piston Park, Scotty's, and Northfield.



Expandable Travel Trailers or Hybrids are travel trailers, but possess fold-down tents at the ends, and/or sides, for sleeping. Limited Family Camping Sites are able to accommodate the size of these type of campers.

Permitted in: Family (size limited), Wilson's Fence Row, Scotty's, and Northfield.



The **Pop-Up Camper**, also known as a **Tent Trailer**, is a great lightweight unit like a hybrid between tent camping and travel trailer camping. These units are smaller and less expensive than travel trailers while offering many of the same conveniences.

Permitted in: Family, Wilson's Fence Row, Scotty's, and Northfield.



All **Tent** styles, whether a simple single person or larger multi-room unit.

Permitted in: Family, Wilson's Fence Row, Scotty's, and Northfield.

FACILITY REGULATIONS

ASPHALT

Summit Motorsports Park is a family owned and operated business that takes tremendous pride in its facility; much the same way you take pride in your race operation! As a result, I respectfully ask that you not penetrate our asphalt with screws, nails, spikes or stakes. Penetrating the asphalt will result in a \$500 fine per hole, and additionally, can lead to expulsion from the event!

ELECTRICAL BOXES

All electrical boxes have been secured with meter tags to ensure safety and the integrity of the power supply. Again, I am asking you to respect Summit Motorsports Park property. Do not tamper with the boxes/break the tag to gain access to the box. Anyone who violates this policy will be fined \$250, and risk possible expulsion from the event!

OIL DISPOSAL

We ask that you properly dispose your oil, filters, etc. in a designated receptacle. We have one designated location on the Ohio Cat (East) Side of the track next to the Dornan Sales & Service Tire Center and one designated location on the Summit (West) Side of the track at the southeast corner of our campground. Please do not leave oil in your pit space, additionally, please take great care to not spill any oil on the ground. Anyone who violates this policy will be fined \$250, and risk possible expulsion from the event!

HOT COAL DISPOSAL

We ask that you properly cool hot items prior to disposing of them. This includes but it not limited to coal, ashes, and cigarettes. We take great pride in the appearance of our facility. With most of our trash bins being plastic, the hot items are melting the bin and damaging the asphalt underneath. Anyone who violates this policy will be fined \$250, and risk possible expulsion from the event!

WASTEWATER

By definition, "Gray Water" is water that flows from places such as showers, basins, baths and washing machines. "Black (or Brown) Water" is generated from places such as toilets and dishwashers. The level of contamination is high. Summit Motorsports Park prohibits guests from the disposing or dumping of both "Gray" and "Black or Brown" water from any living quarters onto any Summit Motorsports Park property. Doing so is a vile and disrespectful act punishable by a lifetime suspension from Summit Motorsports Park. We offer a daily pumping service for any guests that need to have their living quarters pumped.
