SPORTSMAN WORLD FINALS CLASS RULES

GENERAL: IHRA electronics rules strictly enforced and vehicles may be inspected at any time. Downtrack electronic RPM limiting devices, throttle stops, non-OEM onboard computers, GPS or track positioning sensing devices and wheel pickup sensors are prohibited. Vehicles may only be driven by one driver.

BOX (ELECTRONICS) (0-9.00): Delay boxes, trans brakes, two steps, playback delay boxes, playback tachometers starting line enhancers and nitrous are permitted. Air throttles used as launch control devices are permitted. Factory (OEM) installed computers will be permitted, but laptop computers are not allowed while in competition. Deep staging not permitted. Cross talk is always on and cannot be turned off.

NO BOX (NO ELECTRONICS) (All Run): Delay boxes, air throttles, and starting line enhancers are prohibited. Trans brakes, two-steps, automated shifters and nitrous are permitted. Delay boxes are not allowed to remain in the vehicle. EV permitted.

SPORTSMAN (7.40 & Slower, Door Cars Only): Delay boxes, air throttles, starting line enhancers, trans brakes, two steps, buttons on the steering wheel and nitrous are prohibited. Two steps permitted on manual transmissions only. Slicks and headers are permitted. Line locks are only permitted in the burnout process. The throttle must be manually operated by the driver's foot. Electronics, pneumatics, hydraulics, or any other device may in no way affect the throttle operation. A fixed stop under the carburetor or gas pedal is permitted. Automated Shifter is prohibited unless OEM. EV permitted.

MOTORCYCLES/SLEDS (All Run): Delay boxes, two steps, playback tachometers and nitrous are permitted. Air throttles, used as launch control devices, are permitted. Factory (OEM) installed computers will be permitted, but laptop computers are not allowed while in competition.

JUNIORS (All Run): Dial-in must be on vehicle. All IHRA junior rules apply per the competitors license level and as written in the IHRA rulebook. EV permitted. Juniors will be separated into three classes (7.50/7.90); (8.90); (11.90/13.90) but will not have class specific bye runs. One bye run only per Junior round. An odd number of cars in any class may result in different classes running each other at any time.

SPORTSMAN WORLD FINALS EVENT RACE PROCEDURES

- The Sportsman World Finals will be run on a 1/8-mile format.
- Bikes and sleds can run against cars if they qualify in Box or No Box.
- Competitors will be run on a random pull system throughout eliminations. Lane preference will be determined by the lane the racer enters. Card draw will determine uneven pairs.
- First-round potential bye determined by best reaction time from the 2ND qualifying session on Saturday. Ties broken by first to accomplish. Further rounds are reaction time in previous round and ties broken by package, then first to accomplish. Bye-runs do not carry over. A racer is eligible for a bye until he/she makes one. Once a racer makes a bye, they are not eligible again until everyone else left in the class has made a bye run. A potential bye that is paired has lane choice.
- Courtesy staging is mandatory in all classes. Deep stagers will courtesy stage by lighting both pre-stage and stage bulbs if "DEEP" is clearly marked on all sides of the vehicle. Deep staging in a timely manner is the sole responsibility of the driver.
- Dial-ins cannot be changed past the designated ready line.
- Junior tire covers may be removed after the water.

SUMMIT MOTORSPORTS PARK FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How may I contact the track?

A: Our regular phone is (419) 668-5555 available during regular office hours and while open during events. During events, our texting line will be available 24/7 for inquiry or reporting problems/guest issues. Please text (419) 554-0550.

Q: Do you have an ATM?

A: An ATM is available at Guest Services.

Q: How may I secure my canopies or etc in the pits?

A: There is absolutely NO STAKING allowed in the asphalt. We do provide concrete buckets with hooks to help you secure your canopies, tents, or etc. These are located on the Pit side between Dornan's Part Shop and Golf Cart Rental buildings and are available on a first come first serve basis at no cost. Please return when finished.

Q: Where may I dispose of waste oil?

A: There is a large barrel for waste oil in the yellow Safety Kleen shed near Dornan's (along the 601 fence on the Pit side) as well as in the SE corner of family camping on the Summit Side.

Q: Do you provide a dump station or somewhere I can dispose of grey water?

A: We do not have an onsite dump station and do not permit any emptying or disposal onsite but have a dump truck from Kurtzman's Sanitation that will come during events to service guests. Please check the event schedule for when we are expecting them, and flag them down when you see them. Their rate is \$35 for each service. We have a list of area dump stations as well.

Q: Do you have a water fill station onsite?

A: While we do not have a place to fill onsite, we do have an outside water hauling company that comes in for most events and you may pay directly. Please check with the office or guest services for event specific information. You may leave your name, phone number, and location with the nearest gate staff and they will give the list to them so they stop by your site.

Q: Where do I collect payout?

A: Summit Motorsports Park issues payout from Guest Services. Some event promoters handle their own payout- you can check with your event coordinator or stop in at Guest Services for direction.

Q: Do you sell ice?

A: Yes, ice is available at the permanent concession buildings.

Q: Do you have showers on site?

A: Showers are located in the restrooms behind the Ohio CAT grandstands with hours posted on the doors, and the Shower Tickets may be purchased at the Throttle Town Grille.

Q: May we bring in a golf cart/ATV/etc?

A: the use of golf carts is permitted so long as the regulations are followed:

- 1. Only guests with a valid driver's license are permitted to operate a motorized vehicle.*
- 2. Guests operating a motorized vehicle are expected to follow a posted maximum speed limit of 10 milesper-hour.*
- 3. Guests under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not permitted to operate a motorized vehicle.*
- 4. High speeds, or dangerous/reckless behavior when operating a motorized vehicle is prohibited.*

Q: May I rent a golf cart onsite?

A: For most events golf cart rentals are available. Call Dornan's at (419) 912-4028 to reserve, or while onsite during events call (419) 663-2254 to reach them at the Track.
