## Positions Available:

- **Starter:** Starts the race and keeps the starting line clear of debris and fluids
- **Water Box:** Prepares the water box for burnouts and keeps the area clear of excess rubber, debris and fluids
- **Head of Staging:** Unloads cars from the staging lanes, report car information to timing tower
- **Rear of Staging:** Loads cars into staging lanes
- **ET Shack:** Hands out elapsed time slips to competitors after their track run
- **Tech Inspector:** Mechanical background required. Ensures competing cars are safe and legal
- **Back Computer/Handicaps:** The back computer operator is responsible for entering all the drive and car data into our database. Driver name, year, make & model of the car as well as the car number. You will also be working with the head of staging official and write down the car numbers and dial-ins called up during eliminations.
- **Front Computer:** Adding car numbers from cars in the burnout box during time trials. The front computer operator is responsible for entering all car numbers and dial-ins into the computer during eliminations.
- If you don't understand one or more of these terms don't worry! No drag racing background is required. Our experienced team will provide all training. Here is what is required:
  - Must be 18 years or older
  - Work effectively in a team environment and take direction. We work closely with one another at a very fast pace.
  - Prior equipment experience is not necessary but is preferred. You must be comfortable and willing to learn to operate equipment used to clean up debris and fluids and to dry the track.
  - Communicate professionally. Good verbal communication skills are required for interaction with your team members and all our guests
  - Reliable transportation. Our days start early and can sometimes end late, reliable and dependable transportation is a must whether it's your vehicle or someone bringing you to work
  - Stamina. Work is performed outdoors and the hours can be long. Endurance is a must! Be part of something great ... join our exceptional team for the experience of a lifetime!
