As we mark the first year of the World Changers Initiative (2024-2026), we are deeply grateful for all that the Lord has done in 2024. As this financial year comes to a close, we are reminded of Jesus' charge to us as His disciples—to go and bear fruit.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to everyone who has contributed through prayer and financial support to make this possible.

5. Excellence: We are honorable, fast, and reliable.

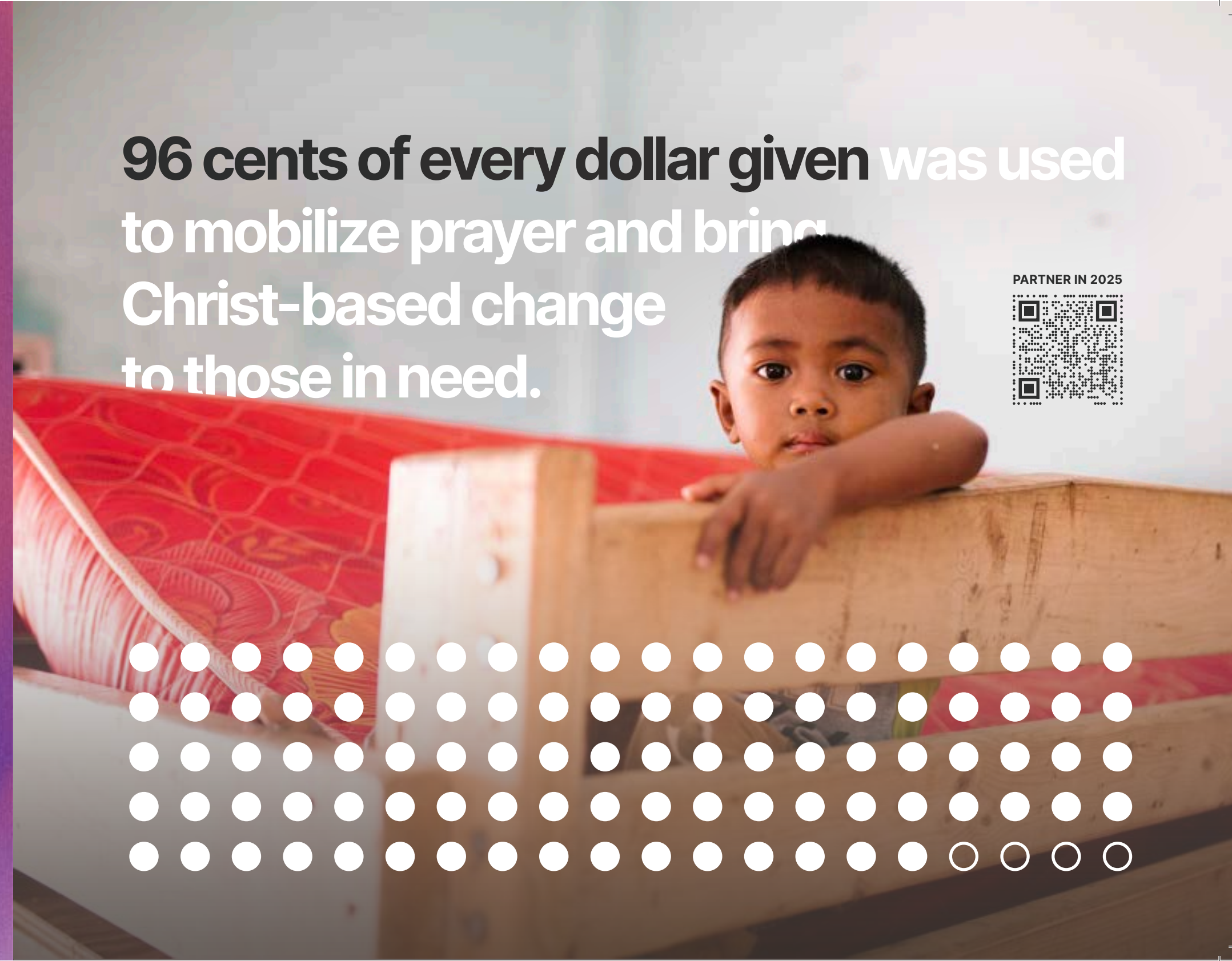
The World Changers Vision:

- Build 30 sustainable harvest centers

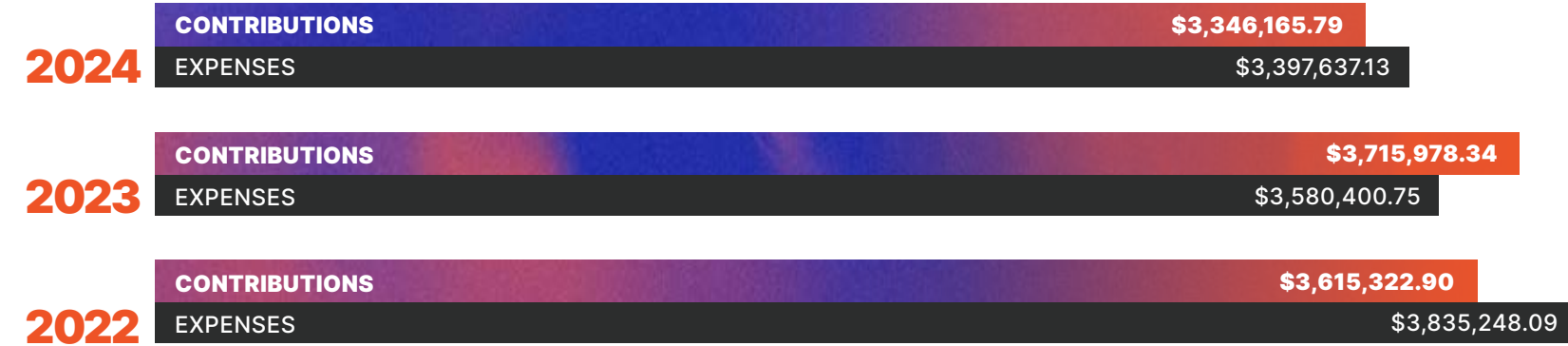

The Vision: A Closer Look

Cultivate prayer communities in 237 nations/territories

At its core, SEAPC is a global Christian community that believes lives and nations are changed through prayer. Wherever there are people, there is a need for humble servants of God to pray for and with those people. SEAPC's goal is to establish a prayer community, or a group of prayer walking Christians, in every nation - ones who are eager to walk in the resurrection power of Christ, to pray over their communities, families, and local leaders, and to see Christ-based change as a result.

Translate Biblical resources into 30 languages

For years, SEAPC has worked side-by-side with ministries around the globe, to provide Biblical curriculum, prayer walking guides, and other faith-building resources for nations in need. Translation is arduous work, and involves many different skill sets. Teams of talented, mission-minded translators are striving diligently to provide these spiritually rich materials to people groups who have traditionally been underserved and unnoticed.

Facilitate Attack Lambs training in 132 nations

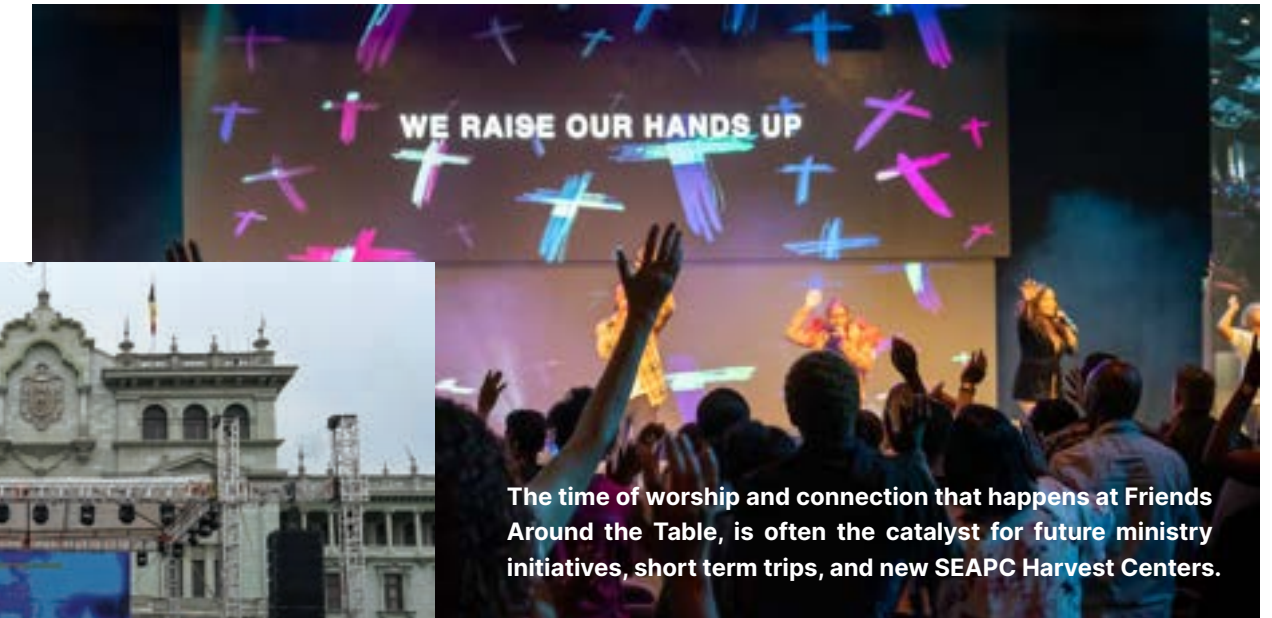
SEAPC founder, Mark Geppert, wrote *The Attack Lambs: Prayer That Changes the World* to teach people the power of walking while praying. The concept of prayer walking is a core foundation of everything done at SEAPC and is one of the reasons SEAPC was founded. The Attack Lambs is an educational resource for any Christian who desires to pray more intentionally and effectively but doesn't know where to begin.

Bring human, material, and spiritual resources to 50 nations

What started years ago as serving a medical need in Tibet has grown into a global effort to shower the nations with resources vital for community health and growth. These resources fall into four different categories: education, parenting, healthcare, and economic development. SEAPC ministry partners include schools, children's homes, trade school programs, medical clinics, and many more.

Build 30 sustainable harvest centers

SEAPC desires to see more ministry centers established, continuing the work of Christ in their communities while also sending out resources to other nations. These harvest centers are sustainable extensions of the SEAPC ministry network, and although each one may look a little different from the rest, they all share the same burden, the same Christ-centered mission, the same values, and the same goals.



The time of worship and connection that happens at Friends Around the Table, is often the catalyst for future ministry initiatives, short term trips, and new SEAPC Harvest Centers.



Inspired through Friends Around the Table Guatemala, Christians gathered in Guatemala City to pray, worship, and unite in Jesus.



At one point, the crowd in Guatemala City reached five thousand, as people of all ages and backgrounds joined together to pray.



Another outgrowth of Friends Around the Table was the Youth on Fire trip to Sao Paulo, Brazil. Young people ministered through various platforms, both in the city and in two remote villages.

A Group of 5,000 Walked and Prayed over Guatemala City

In cities around the world, unity in prayer is transforming communities. What began as a vision during Friends Around the Table (FATT) Guatemala 2022 became reality in September 2024, when 5,000 people gathered for a March for Jesus in Guatemala City. Led by local pastors and inspired by Pastor Laxer Ramirez, a friend of SEAPC, churches came together to pray, worship, and unite in Jesus. The march ended at the National Palace with a powerful time of worship, marking a historic moment of unity in the city.

This same spirit of prayer and service is taking root in Brazil. Out of FATT Brazil 2023, two SEAPC USA residents, Mikeiya from Pennsylvania and Leticia from Brazil, trained and equipped a Youth on Fire team—10 young leaders from seven local churches. These youth joined nearly 200 people from Bíblia Da Paz Church in São Paulo, serving communities through medical outreach, evangelism, prayer walking, and youth ministry. Their work reached São Paulo, Cananeia, and two indigenous villages in the Vale do Ribeira region, bringing hope and transformation.

As these movements grow, the goal remains the same—to see the next generation rise up in prayer and take action, impacting their cities and nations for Christ.

This is just one example of many great things that happened within the SEAPC global community in 2024.

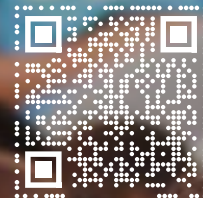
What started years ago as serving a medical need in Tibet has grown into a global mission—bringing education, parenting support, and healthcare initiatives to communities in need. Today, this work is reaching further than ever before. In Cambodia alone, 150,000 children across 488 public schools receive Christ-centered education daily.

Parenting initiatives have expanded, with 26% of every dollar given supporting efforts to care for vulnerable children. Seventeen children's homes now provide shelter for over 700 kids, with nearly 100 waiting for sponsorship. In the past year, 11 homes—10 in Cambodia and one in Myanmar—have been repaired, renovated, or newly built.

Healthcare efforts continue to transform lives, with over 300,000 children and family members living with autism receiving care in 2024. Through these initiatives, a total of 68 nations have been impacted.

Turkmenistan Tajikistan

Grow Mongolia, a ministry partner of SEAPC, worked alongside Mongolian and local churches in Turkmenistan to equip believers with The Attack Lambs Training, strengthening the prayer walking movement and deepening local ministry efforts.

The Gateway Project (ministry partner) brought together ministries from around the world to equip and empower local believers in reaching the unreached. Teams were trained and then prayer walked through key areas, building connections with local churches and ministries. These efforts established a strongprayer community in one of the world's most unreached regions within the 10/40 window.

Democratic Republic of the Congo

Acts Church of South Africa, one of many churches that partner with SEAPC, established a church plant in Kinshasa. This church has been actively prayer-walking the capital city, covering it in intercession. This effort strengthens the spiritual foundation of the community and supports the growth of the local church.

For decades, prayer has shaped Russia's transformation. In the 1980s, Matt's father—SEAPC Founder Mark Geppert—was used of God to lead teams in prayer walking the Trans-Siberian Railroad, interceding for the nation. Now, that legacy continues. The work to translate the Attack Lambs prayer guide was begun in 2024. By January 2025 it was fully translated into Russian, reaching 116 million speakers. Grow Mongolia helped complete the translation. Amid war and uncertainty, this resource empowers Russian-speaking believers to lead prayer walks, interceding for their communities and sharing the Gospel.

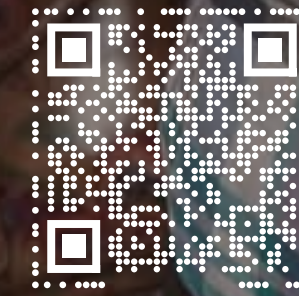

The Attack Lambs Taught to 60 Prison Chaplains Across Kenya,

Reaching 90k+ Prisoners

In Kenya, a powerful movement of prayer is spreading behind prison walls. Through relationships formed in Friends Around the Table Kenya (2022), Acts Church of South Africa began teaching Attack Lambs to 60 prison chaplains via Zoom. These chaplains are now bringing the training into prisons, reaching and impacting approximately 90,000 prisoners with the power of prayer.

As of March 2025, trainings have expanded to equip more chaplains in Kenya and Tanzania, and have continued to strengthen this growing network of intercessors. A potential trip to visit every prison in Kenya is now being lifted in prayer—an opportunity to directly teach both staff and prisoners and see lives transformed from the inside out.
