

14-Day New York, Boston & Maine Coastal Adventure

Day 1: Arrival in New York City

Day 11: Kennebunkport & the Bush Compound

Heading south, stop in Kennebunkport to view Walker's Point, the Bush family's summer retreat. Explore boutiques, galleries, and sandy beaches before spending the night in Kennebunkport or nearby Portland, where coastal elegance meets small-town charm.

Day 12: Freeport & Portland

Pause in Freeport to browse the flagship L.L. Bean store and local shops before arriving in Portland. Wander through the Old Port historic district, savoring lunch by the harbor. Don't miss a stop at Portland Head Light, Maine's most photographed lighthouse, before spending the night in the city.

Day 13: Coastal Maine Farewell
