Aassmaa Akhannouch

Born in Meknes, Morocco in 1973, Aassmaa Akhannouch lives and works between the south of France and Casablanca. She first obtained an engineering degree in France and an MBA in the United States and worked in marketing for 15 years. In 2013, she attended the Photo Academy Casablanca to perfect her knowledge in digital photography and in 2016, decided to devote herself entirely to the practice of photography. She is supported in her research by artist FLORE, through her photographic studio L'Oeil de l'Esprit in Paris.

With her images, Aassmaa Akhannouch tells us stories, fragments of memories exposed freely to the associative imagination and emotions of the viewer. Beyond the intention to document a personal past, the artist attempts to bring up intimate emotions, to reveal lyrical and timeless impressions. Using alternative processes and watercolour highlights that make each piece unique, she sucesses in creating images both familiar and fascinating.

In 2021, Aassmaa Akhannouch is awarded the Prix HSBC pour la Photographie, along with Cyrus Cornut. That same year she is selected to show her work at the ManifestO festival, Rencontres Photographiques de Toulouse.
