Surah Al-Rahmān

Introduction & Virtues

- Surah al-Rahman is a Makkan surah
- Surah number: 55
- The Prophet ﷺ recited Surah al-Rahman when he was in a place called Nakhlah. A group of Jinn heard him reciting it and they accepted Islam.
- The Prophet ﷺ once recited Surah al-Rahman to the companions. When he finished, they were all silent. The Prophet ﷺ said:

لَقَدْ قَرَأْتُهَا عَلَى الْجِنِّ لَيْلَةَ الْجِنِّ فَكَانُوا أَحْسَنَ مَرْدُودًا مِنْكُمْ كُنْتُ كُلَّمَا أَتَيْتُ عَلَى قَوْلِهِ
(فَبِأَيِّ آلَاءِ رَبِّكُمَا تُكَذِّبَانِ) قَالُوا: لَا بِشَيْءٍ مِنْ نِعَمِكَ رَبَّنَا نَكْذِبُ فَلَكَ الْحَمْدُ

I recited it to the jinn on the night they came to me and they responded better than you. Whenever I came to the words, "Then which of the favors of your Lord do you deny?" they replied, "We deny none of Your favors, O our Lord. To You be the praise."

- Ibn Abbas narrated:

قَالَ أَبُو بَكْرٍ: يَا رَسُولَ اللَّهِ قَدْ شَبْتُ. قَالَ: شَيَّبْتَنِي هُودٌ وَالْوَاقِعَةُ وَالْمُرْسَلَاتُ وَعَمَّ
يَتَسَاءَلُونَ وَإِذَا الشَّمْسُ كُوِّرَتْ

Abu Bakr RA said: 'O Messenger of Allah! You have become gray-haired.' He said: 'I have gone gray from (Surat) Hud, Al-Waqi'ah, Al-Mursalat and `Ammat Yata'salun and Idhash-Shamsu Kuwwirat.'"

- Ibn Masud narrated:

I heard the Prophet SAW say: whoever recites sūra al-Waqi'ah every night will never be afflicted by poverty.
