Course Descriptions:

Code of Manners: Imam Al Bukhari Al-Adab Al-Mufrad

Imam al-Bukhari's Sahih is such a monumental work; it often overshadows the other gems this great Imam left behind. His dedicated work on mannerisms, appropriately titled "al-Adab al-Mufrad" is one such gem. He gathered more than 1200 Hadith relating to all spheres of ethics and mannerisms one can think of.

Code Of Manners is a study of select Hadith from this work along with commentary. Students will learn about Imam al-Bukhari's life and works, the themes and organization of his work, along with frank discussions on today's ethics, morals, relationships and how we are to navigate them in light of Prophetic advice.

Connected: Fiqh of Salah

Salah is an act of worship we repeat multiple times every day. Considering it is our primary connection with Allah ﷺ, we don't want to be performing it in the wrong manner.

Connected will offer a complete breakdown of Salah, including prerequisites and an end to end walkthrough. Issues such as the Adhan, Congregational Salah, the integrals, nullifiers and Jumuah will also be discussed. This class will leave you with a clear roadmap of the laws, rulings and procedures related to the external aspects of Salah.
