# Introduction

- Name: Abdullah ibn Abi Quhāfa
- Titles: Ṣiddīq and ‘Atīq
- Father: Abu Quhāfa
- Mother: Umm al-Khayr
- Daughters: Aisha, Asmā’, and Umm Kulthum
- Sons: Abdullah, AbdulRahman, and Muhammad
- Abu Bakr was born 2-3 years after the Prophet ﷺ
- Tribe: Banu Taym

## Virtues

*Abdullah b. Masud reported Allah's Messenger SAW as saying:  
If I were to choose a close friend I would have definitely chosen  
Abu Bakr as my close friend, but he is my brother and my  
companion and Allah has taken your brother and companion  
(meaning Prophet himself) as a friend. (Muslim)*

# Abu Bakr's Qualities

- Generosity
  - Abu Bakr constantly freed slaves
  - He gave the most during the Battle of Tabuk
  - The Prophet ﷺ said, “The wealth of no one has benefited me as much as the wealth of Abu Bakr.” (Musnad Ahmad)
- Truthfulness
  - Abu Bakr believed in the Prophet ﷺ without hesitation
  - He believed the Prophet ﷺ when the disbelievers told him about the journey of Isrā' & Mi'rāj

# Abu Bakr's Khilafa

- Abu Bakr was selected as the first Khalifa
- Accomplishments during his Khilafa:
  - Fought against those who denied Zakah (Ridda Wars)
  - Compiled the Quran into one copy
  - Sent Khalid ibn al-Walid on conquests against the Byzantine empire
- His Khilafa lasted a little over 2 years

# Death

- Abu Bakr passed away 2 years after the Prophet's ﷺ demise
- He passed away on a Monday at the age of 63, as did the Prophet ﷺ
- The cause of his death was a fever
- After consulting other sahaba, Abu Bakr chose Umar to be the next Khalifa
  - Abu Bakr advised Umar, "If you follow my advice, nothing unknown will be more acceptable to you than death; but if you reject it, nothing unknown will be more frightening than death."
- He was buried next to the Prophet ﷺ

- Titles: al-Fārūq and 'Amīr al-Mu'minīn
- Father: Khaṭṭāb ibn Nufayl
- Mother: Ḥantamah bint Hāshim
- Daughter: Ḥafṣa
- Sons: Abdullah, Ubaydullah, Asim, and Zayd
- Umar was born 13 years after the Prophet ﷺ
- Tribe: Banu Adiy

# Virtues

*Narrated 'Uqbah bin 'Amir: that the Messenger of Allah SAW said: "If there was to be a Prophet after me, it would have been 'Umar bin Al-Khattab." (Tirmidhi)*

## Virtues

*Narrated Abu Huraira: While we were with Allah's Messenger SAW he said, "While I was sleeping, I saw myself in Paradise, and suddenly I saw a woman performing ablution beside a palace. I asked, 'For whom is this palace?' They replied, 'It is for 'Umar.' Then I remembered 'Umar's Ghira (self-respect) and went away quickly." 'Umar wept and said, O Allah's Messenger! How dare I think of my ghira (self-respect) being offended by you?*

# Umar's Qualities

- Brave and courageous
  - Umar openly declared his Islam
  - The Muslims did Tawaf publicly as a group for the first time with Umar as their leader in Makkah
  - He often challenged others and fought in many battles
- Knowledgeable
  - Allah revealed multiple verses that agreed with the opinion of Umar
  - The Prophet ﷺ said, “While I was sleeping, I saw myself drinking (milk), and I was so contented that I saw the milk flowing through my nails. Then I gave (the milk) to Umar.” The companions asked, “What do you interpret it?” He ﷺ said, “Knowledge.” (Sahih Bukhari)

# Umar's Khilafa

- Accomplishments during his Khilafa:
  - Founded the lunar calendar according to the hijrah
  - Conquered Jerusalem
  - Expanded the Islamic Empire at an unprecedented rate
  - Implemented political and civil administration jobs (chief secretary, treasury officer, etc.)
  - Appointed police forces to keep civil order
- His Khilafa lasted for 10 years

# Death

- Umar passed away when he was 63 years old in the 23<sup>rd</sup> year after hijrah
- Umar used to make dua, “Oh Allah! I ask you for martyrdom in Your cause and death in the land of Your Messenger ﷺ.”
- While Umar was leading Fajr prayer in Madinah, he was stabbed by Abu Lu’lu’
- Umar had requested from Aisha that he be burried next to the Prophet ﷺ and Abu Bakr, so the people burried him there
