


Characteristic of Ism #4: Number - عَدَد

- Recall, there are 4 characteristics of an Ism:
 - Definite/Indefinite (مُعْرِفَة/نَكِرَة)
 - Gender (مُؤَنَّث/مُذَكَّر)
 - Grammatical State (إِغْرَاب - رَفْع/نَصْب/جَر)
 - Quantity (عَدَد)
- A noun can be singular (مُفَزَّد) (تَنْبِيَة), dual (تَنْبِيَة), or plural (جَمْع) (تَنْبِيَة)

Dual Nouns

- The grammatical state of a dual noun is reflected as shown in the diagram below




- Example: you could say سَيَارَتَانِ or سَيَارَتَيْنِ depending on the grammatical state the word should be in
- Dual nouns will always end with a kasra

Plural Nouns

- There are 2 types of plural nouns
 - 1) Sound (plurals in which the root letters are never separated or broken)
 - 2) Broken (plurals in which the root letters are separated)

Sound Plurals

- There are 2 types of sound nouns
 - 1) Masculine
 - Will always end with a single fatha
 - 2) Feminine
 - will always end with ات
 - They cannot end with a fatha or fathatayn
- The diagram below shows the structure of sound plurals



- Example: you could say لَاعِبَنَ or لَاعِبَاتْ for males and لَاعِبَاتِ for females
- This chart provides an example of the word مُسْلِمٌ in all grammatical states, for both males and females.

Broken Plurals

- Broken plurals do not follow specific rules.
- You can identify the correct form of a broken plural by looking up its singular form in the dictionary.
- Below are some examples of broken plurals.

بُيُوتُ	←	بَيْتٌ
كُتُبُ	←	كِتَابٌ
دُرُوسُ	←	دَرْسٌ
بِلَادُ	←	بَلَدٌ
رَجَالُ	←	رَجُلٌ
أَقْلَامُ	←	قَلْمَنْ

- * General rule to keep in mind: the مُبْتَدأ and خَبَر of a sentence must match in gender and quantity.
 - Example: المُسْلِمَانِ خَاسِعَانِ
