

VAGINAL ISSUES? YOU ARE NOT ALONE!

- 33% of women experience bladder leakage when they laugh, sneeze, or workout.

WHY CONSIDER VAGINAL REJUVENATION?

Vaginal rejuvenation restores sexual comfort by increasing vaginal lubrication and reducing dryness. Improved lubrication lessens the tearing sensation (feeling of broken glass) that many women experience during sex after menopause. It also strengthens the urethra to reduce urinary leakage, rebalances the vaginal pH to prevent infection, and stops the feelings of constant vaginal irritation..

WHAT IS FEMILIFT?

The FemiLift is an FDA-approved CO2 laser that rejuvenates the vaginal walls. The laser treatment stimulates collagen and elastin production. This improves blood flow to the vagina. and strengthens the vaginal walls. The FemiLift promotes stronger and healthier tissue, restores vaginal lubrication, and improves sexual comfort.

- Recurrent Vaginal and Urinary Infections: Reduces infections by restoring the vagina's normal pH.
- <u>Post-Surgery Recovery:</u> Accelerates the healing process after a hysterectomy or vaginal surgery by promoting collagen production.
- <u>Vaginal Laxity:</u> Restores sexual sensitivity by thickening and toning the vaginal walls.
- <u>Postpartum Recovery</u>: Aids in the restoration of vaginal tightness and lessens urinary leakage after childbirth.

IS THE FEMILIFT EFFECTIVE?

Yes! In clinical studies, 90% of women reported improvement in their symptoms of vaginal dryness, urinary leakage, and painful sex in as little as three treatments.

We recommend 3-5 treatments, depending on your individual situation. Results typically last 1-2 years. A touch up treatment every year will help you maintain your results.

HOW IS FEMILIFT DIFFERENT?

Most vaginal rejuvenation treatments use a vaginal probe that heats the vaginal tissue to tighten the vaginal walls. However, most other treatments do not restore vaginal health. Additionally, they are imprecise, can be painful, and can lead to vaginal burns. The FemiLift is the only FDA-approved Co2 laser that delivers controlled thermal energy to stimulate collagen production, which is the key to vaginal health.

HOW DOES FEMILIFT WORK?

The FemiLift is a 20 minute in-office procedure that is performed by a licensed medical provider. A thin vaginal probe is inserted into the vagina. The probe delivers painless CO2 energy to the vaginal walls in a 360-degree fashion. The process is quick, involves minimal discomfort, and is similar to a pelvic exam.
