Please start early.

There are a few days between submitting your written application and receiving access to the video assessment platform. You'll also want time to practice before recording. So please make sure to complete this written application at **least three working days before the deadline** so you can move smoothly to the video stage.

Recommendation: Finish this written application by Wednesday December 31 at the latest. Complete all other parts (incl video assessment) by January 5, 2026, 23:59 CET.

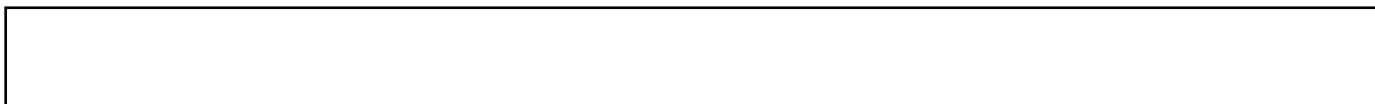
