Requirements:

- Provide itemized invoice of equipment with manufacture name and model number.
- All equipment must be new and be installed on Red Lake Electric Cooperative's system.
- Electric heating system must be on off-peak with a qualified backup heating system.
- Electric heating must be the primary source designed to heat the building.
- Electric heat is individually metered under a special rate.
- Electric heat equipment must be hard wired (no plug-in loads eligible for rebate).
- Air-source heat pumps and mini-splits do not have to be part of an off-peak heating system to be eligible for this rebate.
- Air-source and ground-source heat pumps must meet the CIP requirements outlined in the electric heat program description.
- Rebate not to exceed more than the purchase price for all eligible heating equipment rebates.

- Must be at least 240 volts and hard wired.
- Tankless water heaters do not qualify for rebate.
- Hybrid heat pump water heaters do not qualify for rebate.
- Multifamily dwellings do not qualify for rebate; however, exceptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
