

**AFTERCARE** 

#### CARE WITH SECOND SKIN FILM \_\_\_\_\_

- Right after tattooing, the Second Skin film is applied. It can remain on your tattoo for 5–7 days.
- On the last day, gently remove the film under the shower.
   Clean the tattoo carefully with pH-neutral soap and rinset well.
- Let the tattoo air dry do not wipe, pat, or blow-dry.
- Afterwards, apply a thin layer of healing ointment. The skin should still be able to breathe – avoid leaving a greasy film
- During the following 7 days, it is recommended to apply the ointment 2–3 times a day in a thin layer.
- After these 7 days, the skin can continue the healing process on its own.

### CARE WITH CLING FILM

(for adhesive allergies)

# First hours after tattooing:

- Your tattoo has been covered with cling film to protect it from dirt and bacteria.
- Leave the film on your skin for 2-4 hours. During this time, avoid strong movement, pressure, or friction on the tattooed area.

# First cleaning – evening before going to bed:

- Carefully remove the film with clean, washed hands. Gently wash the tattoo with lukewarm water and a pH-neutral, unscented soap.
- Let the tattoo air dry.
- Afterwards, re-wrap it in cling film without applying any cream.

### FIRST 2 WEEKS \_\_\_\_\_

- Avoid sports, saunas, full baths, and chlorinated or salt water during this time to allow your skin to regenerate optimally and to minimize the risk of infection.
- Avoid using moisturizing or greasy creams. Do not continue applying any care products during the next 6 weeks your skin will regenerate naturally.
- Do not scratch any touch can interfere with the natural healing process.
- Use only the products recommended by us to achieve the best possible results.

#### FIRST 6 WEEKS AND BEYOND \_\_\_\_\_

- Avoid sun exposure and tanning beds. Your tattoo will appreciate protection and will especially thank you during the first year if it is kept away from direct sunlight.
- In the long term, it is recommended to care for your tattoo with sunscreen SPF 50+.

## NOTES ON NORMAL REACTIONS \_\_\_\_\_

- It is normal for fluid (blood, plasma, or ink) to accumulate under the film. This is no cause for concern please do not pierce the film, as this could allow bacteria to enter. The fluid will dry up naturally between day 3–5.
- Occasionally, the skin may react sensitively to the film –
  for example with redness, small pimples, burning, or
  itching. In that case, carefully remove the film and continue caring for your tattoo as described above.
