EMPOWER INCOME QUALIFIED ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM (LIEEP) EMPOWER

This program provides eligible MARYLAND families with no cost repairs and energy efficiency upgrades to their home to reduce energy usage, potentially providing a more comfortable home and savings on utility bills. MARYLAND ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (MEAP):

MEAP, federally funded through the **LIHEAP** energy assistance program, assists customers with paying their winter heating bills. Grants are based on family size, income and the type of fuel used for heating. Applicants are eligible to apply for the MEAP program only once each program year, July 1 - June 30.

UTILITY SERVICE PROTECTION PROGRAM (USPP):

The **USPP** begins the first week of November and is available to residential customers who are eligible for MEAP. With USPP, participation requires enrollment into a year-round even monthly budget billing program.

WASHINGTON AREA FUEL FUND (WAFF)

Created by Washington Gas in 1983 and administered by The Salvation Army, provides assistance regardless of how families' heat their homes.
