



For Safety Awareness Month, Washington Gas is sharing tips on how to safely use natural gas appliances.

GENERAL APPLIANCE SAFETY

- Keep the space around your furnace and water heaters free of debris.
- · Only have a licensed contractor connect your natural gas appliances.
- Never use an oven or range for heat.

FURNACE SAFETY

- Do not store flammable combustibles such as paint or gasoline around fuel-burning equipment.
- · Replace air filters regularly to reduce dust.

WATER HEATER SAFETY

 Have a contractor perform a maintenance check every 6 months to a year, including temperature/pressure relief valve and venting.
