On July 31, 2025, Washington Gas Light Company ("Washington Gas" or "Company") filed with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application, supporting testimony and schedules, requesting authority to increase its rates and charges, and to revise other terms and conditions applicable to its gas service ("Application"). The Company's proposed rates and charges are designed to increase the Company's annual non-gas base revenue by approximately \$65.4 million, and also to transfer \$38.7 million of SAVE revenues into base rates.

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph (5) of the Order for Notice and Hearing issued on September 5, 2025, Washington Gas files herewith revised tariff pages to implement interim rates, subject to refund with interest, effective for usage beginning December 30, 2025.


