



WASHINGTON GAS SAFETY MONITORING PLAN FOR QUAIL POND COURT AREA

Washington Gas remains firmly committed to the ongoing safety of the Centreville community and has established a comprehensive multi-phased monitoring and leak detection plan for the area outlined in the maps below. This plan was developed in coordination with—and fully approved by—the Virginia State Corporation Commission and the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department.

The ongoing monitoring is an **added precaution** to provide residents with continued confidence and transparency.

Immediate Area Surrounding Incident Site (Map 1)

Phase 1:

› Washington Gas will conduct leak detection surveys 4 times per day for the first week after residents return to their homes.

› At least once per day, the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department will join Washington Gas to conduct a combined survey.

Phase 2:


› Daily surveys for at least 2 weeks.

Phase 3:

› Weekly surveys for at least 2 weeks.

Phase 4:

› Surveys every other week for at least 2 months.





WASHINGTON GAS SAFETY MONITORING PLAN FOR QUAIL POND COURT AREA – CONTINUED

Expanded Area Around the Incident Site (Map 2)

Phase 1:

- › Weekly surveys for at least 1 month.

Phase 2:

- › Monthly surveys for at least 2 months.



This plan ensures that we are checking, rechecking, and validating system stability in a structured and disciplined way over time.

Throughout this process, Washington Gas will continue to closely evaluate all survey results. If conditions change and data indicates that additional monitoring is needed, we are prepared to increase the frequency or scope of our work.
