## Residential Essential Service (RES) Programs

### RES CREDITS

The RES credit program, also known as the Utility Discount Program (UDP), provides significant bill relief to eligible natural-gas customers throughout the year, with the greatest benefits delivered during the colder months when heating costs are highest. Eligible customers will receive an approximate 50% discount on their total bill during the heating months from November through April. This will be achieved through a 100% discount on the distribution service, which includes the customer and distribution charges. The RES credit will appear as a separate line item on customers' bills showing the dollar amount. Eligible households will also receive a 50% discount on the monthly customer charge during the warmer months from May through October.

### AVOIDED COSTS

As a beneficiary of the RES credit, eligible customers are exempt from certain regulatory surcharges. These avoided costs consist of the Sustainable Energy Trust Fund surcharge, the Energy Assistance Trust Fund surcharge and the RES surcharge. The cost of these avoided surcharges is approximately \$6.42 per month, assuming an average RES monthly usage of 92 therms. Customers will see a total of all the surcharges avoided in aggregate, not broken-out individually.

### ELIGIBILITY & RETROACTIVE CREDITS

To be eligible for the RES discount, customers must:

- Use natural gas as the principal source for home heating;
- Be certified by the Department of Energy & Environment (DOEE) as eligible for the Low Income

Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). Retroactive RES credits will be provided for the entire prior heating season for enrollments received up to September 30 each year. Enrollment for the new heating season begins on October 1. Customers must re-enroll for the next heating season.

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Enrollments will be accepted all year, and qualified residents will continue to receive credits throughout the year. Customers must still re-enroll in the program each year and be reapproved by the DOEE.
