

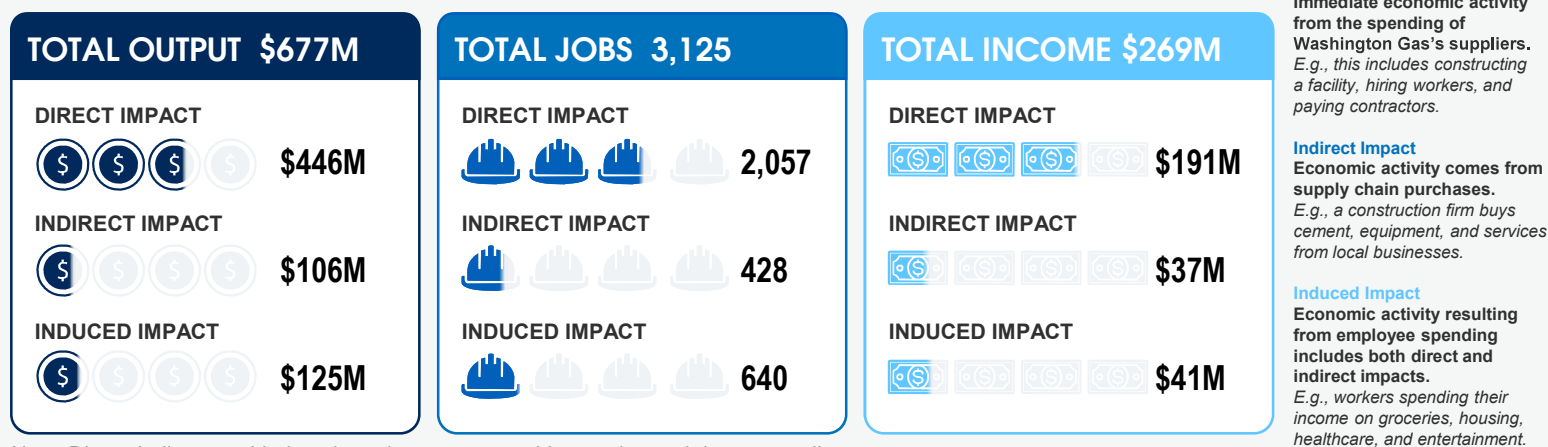
Our Economic Impact In The Communities We Serve
