



ISU Figure Skating European Championships 2027 in Lausanne: Tickets are now available!

Lausanne, 19 June 2026 – Tickets for the ISU Figure Skating European Championships 2027, which will take place from 27 to 31 January 2027 in Lausanne, are now available via Ticketmaster.

Ticket prices have been designed to remain accessible to as many people as possible, including a preferential rate for young people under 16 and students. The ticketing offers session tickets with prices ranging from CHF 24 to CHF 90, a pass granting access to the entire four-day competition, as well as a ticket dedicated to the Exhibition Gala, available from CHF 48.

All competitions will take place at the [Vaudoise Aréna](#), which will be specially adapted and configured to host the ISU Figure Skating European Championships 2027.

A top-tier European field

The competition will bring together Europe's elite in figure skating and will feature a promising Swiss delegation, including Kimmy Repond, bronze medallist at the 2023 European Championships, Lukas Britschgi, 2025 European Champion, as well as the pair Oxana Vouillamoz and Tom Bouvart, who placed fifth at the last European Championships. It represents a unique opportunity for Swiss athletes to shine on home ice in front of the Swiss public.

The event will also benefit from the support of its official ambassadors, Stéphane Lambiel and Denise Biellmann. As iconic figures of Swiss figure skating, both naturally embody this Lausanne edition.
