With Miami serving as a popular housing destination for celebrities—whether it be as a primary place of residence or as a second, third, or even fourth option—we thought it'd be fun to take a look back at 2017's juiciest homes to hit and/or depart the market.

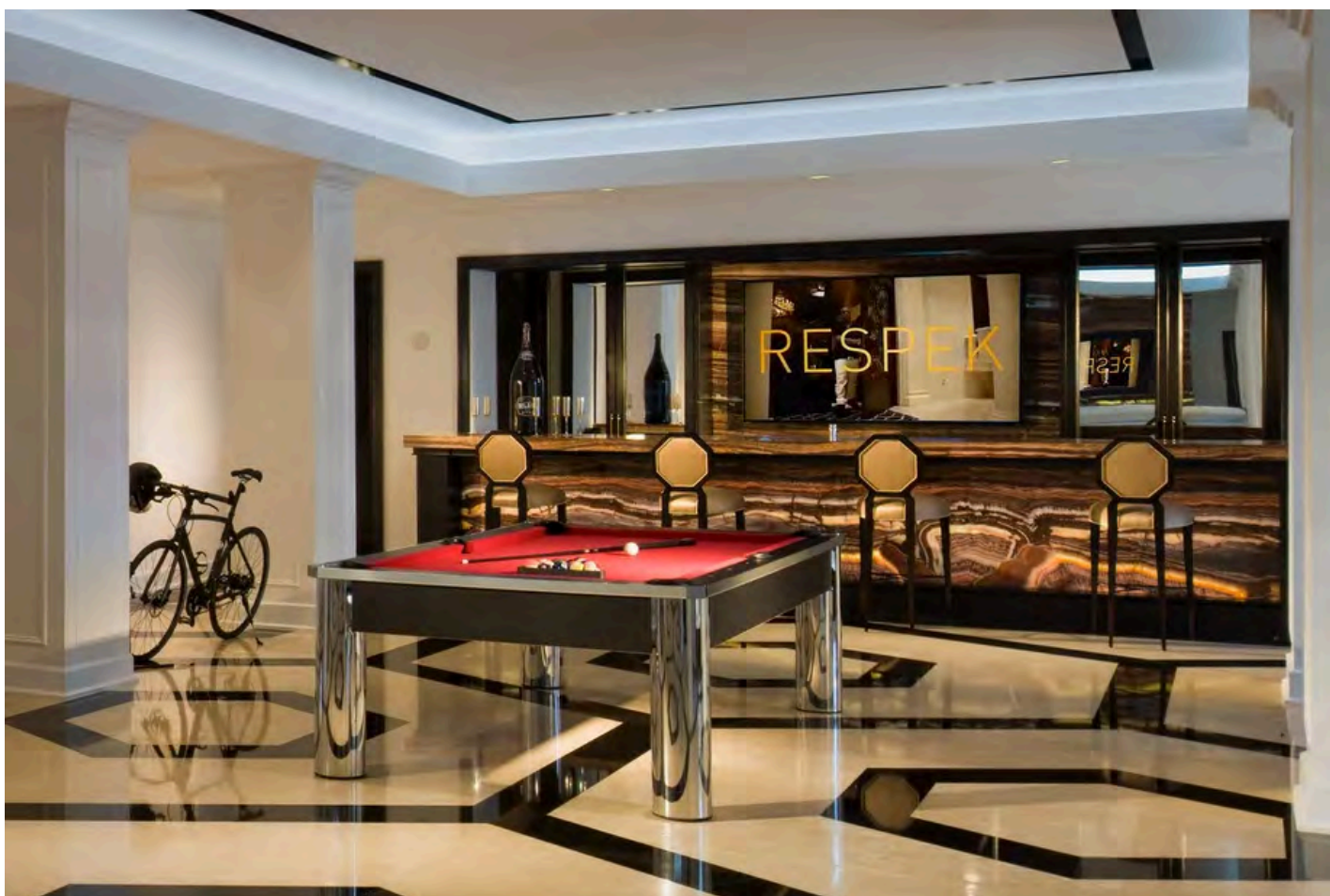
Apologies to Miami Heat guard Dion Waiters, who [landed a 17,700-square-foot mansion in Pinecrest for \\$7.4 million](#) earlier this year because in his mind, he should probably top our list. We settled for an honorable mention.

In no particular order, here are the 10 biggest [celebrity home sales/listings/reductions](#) of the past year in the Miami metro area.

Birdman

It's been a big year for Birdmans living in Miami.

Former Heat center Chris "Birdman" Andersen listed his [Pinecrest residence for \\$4 million](#) while rapper Bryan "Birdman" Williams' respekt-laden mansion in Miami Beach hit the market [asking \\$20 million](#).

Michael Caine

Alfred's South Beach pad is down to \$7.8 million, after asking as much as [\\$8.7 million in July](#). The 4,154-square-foot residence offers four bedrooms, over 2,000 square feet of terrace space, and a home theater, of course.

However, the Apogee Tower condo on the seventh floor is currently listed as pending.

Celine Dion

The legendary singer finally found a buyer for her oceanfront [Florida mansion](#) equipped with a water park in the backyard but the official sale price wasn't anything close to the \$38.5 million that [was initially reported](#).

After first hitting the market for a [whopping \\$72 million in August 2013](#), the 20,000-square-foot estate in Jupiter Island actually sold for \$28 million, [per the Palm Beach Daily News](#), which was less than half of the original ask from nearly four years ago.



Giancarlo Stanton

The reigning National League MVP not only landed a new penthouse in Edgewater but also a new team after the Marlins, a continuous laughingstock of a franchise, shipped their dynamic slugger to the Yankees a few weeks ago.

Perhaps Giancarlo holds onto [his new construction pad](#) overlooking the bay upon completion because he certainly can afford it and it should be a nice investment.

Tommy Hilfiger

Located on Ocean Boulevard in Golden Beach, [the 14,075-square-foot mansion with an ocean for a backyard](#) features interior design by Martyn Lawrence Bullard and includes 100 feet of water frontage. It's now down to \$25.9 million.



Calvin Klein

The notorious fashion designer found a buyer for his waterfront Miami Beach sanctuary, which sold for \$13.15 million last February. The historic 1920s home is located on North Bay Road and initially listed for \$16 million.

Highlighted by 113 feet of unobstructed water frontage along Biscayne Bay, the 5,800-square-foot residence includes yacht dockage, five bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms, and a long infinity pool enclosed by bamboo trees on both sides.

Chris Bosh

Bosh and his wife, Adrienne, [listed their waterfront mansion](#) on North Bay Road for \$18 million a few weeks ago. The 12,368-square-foot modern residence was [built in 2009 and designed by Touzet Studio](#). The Miami Heat legend purchased the home for \$12.33 million in 2010, records show.

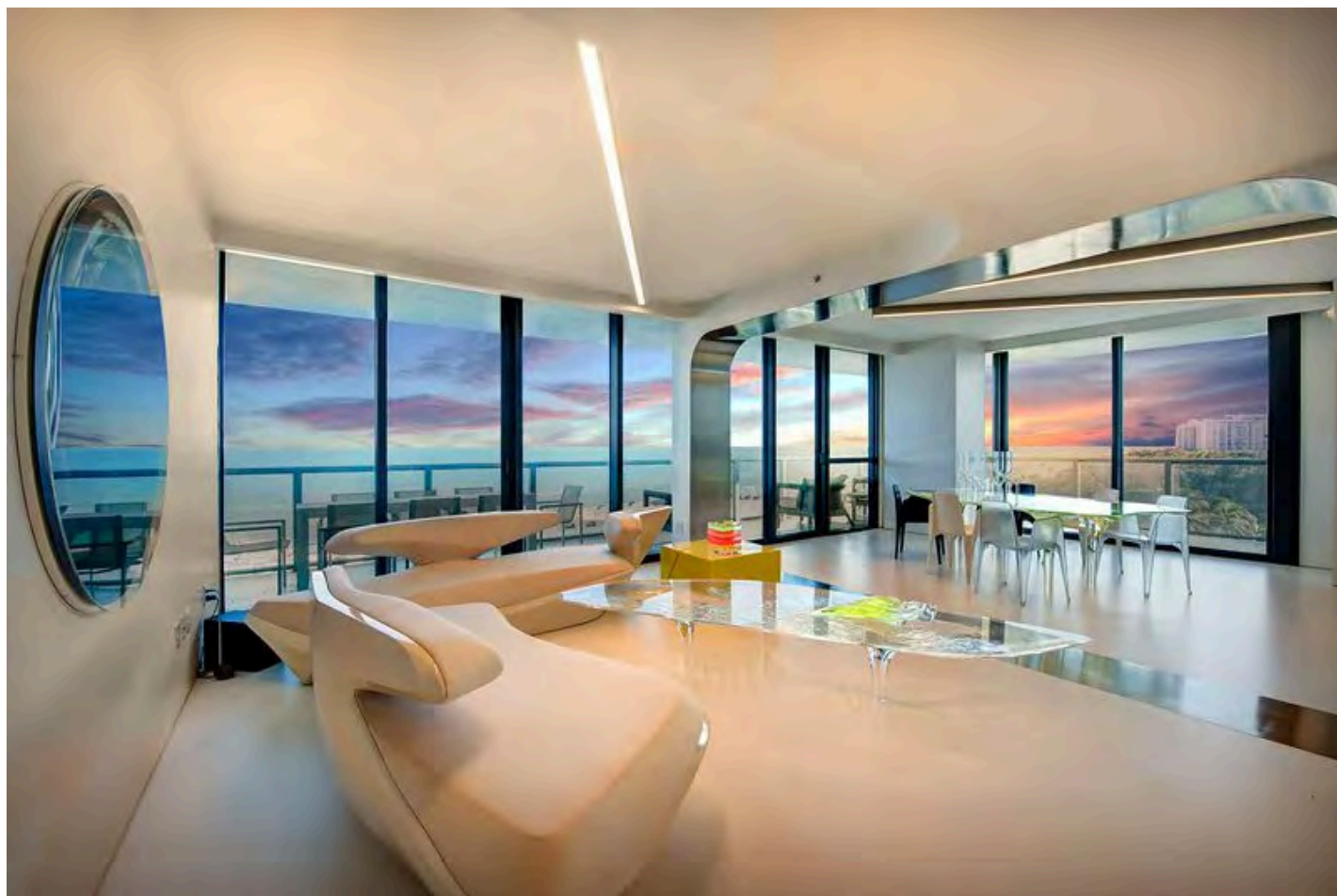

Zaha Hadid

Hadid's unique Miami Beach condo, which originally hit the market in the spring asking \$10 million, re-listed for \$6.5 million in November.

The current ask represents a 35 percent reduction for the stunning former residence of the late Pritzker-winning architect. Located in the W South Beach, the combination unit features the signature curves found across Hadid's sensational projects.

Sofia Vergara

The Modern Family regular [sold her Miami Beach studio for \\$150,000](#) this year. She was living in the unit in the mid-1990s when she first arrived in South Florida to launch her acting and modeling career.

Cervera

Julio Iglesias

The asking price for Julio's four adjacent waterfront lots in Miami Beach's Indian Creek Village: \$150 million!

The prime land (Lots 4-7) faces west, sizing up at eight acres while offering 800 feet of water frontage along Biscayne Bay. The Spanish singer's land encompasses about 10 percent of all the residential property on the island.
