This Bulk Potable Water System is ND Defense's proposed solution for the Water Bison program, which will replace the legacy M149 400-gallon Water Buffalo system currently in use. We are proud to team with Holmwood Highgate for the water tank system.

ND Defense's Bulk Potable Water System has a 530-U.S. gallon tank, which delivers:

- A single Day of Supply (DOS) of potable water to Company-sized units (110-142 Soldiers) minus field feeding operations; or
- Two DOS to support field feeding water requirements of the mobile kitchen trailer and battlefield kitchen.

The tank is capable of operation down to -50° Fahrenheit, featuring:

- A one-inch think closed cell foam with foil covering insulation wrapped in a stainless steel sheet for mechanical protection of the insulation layer; and
- A single heater bar with both 24VDC & 230VAC heating elements.

Dispensing methods include:

- Four ½" spigots (two in winter mode)
- One 2" bulk inlet/outlet
- Top fill through hatch

This highly modular system can be mounted on existing government inventory trailers.
