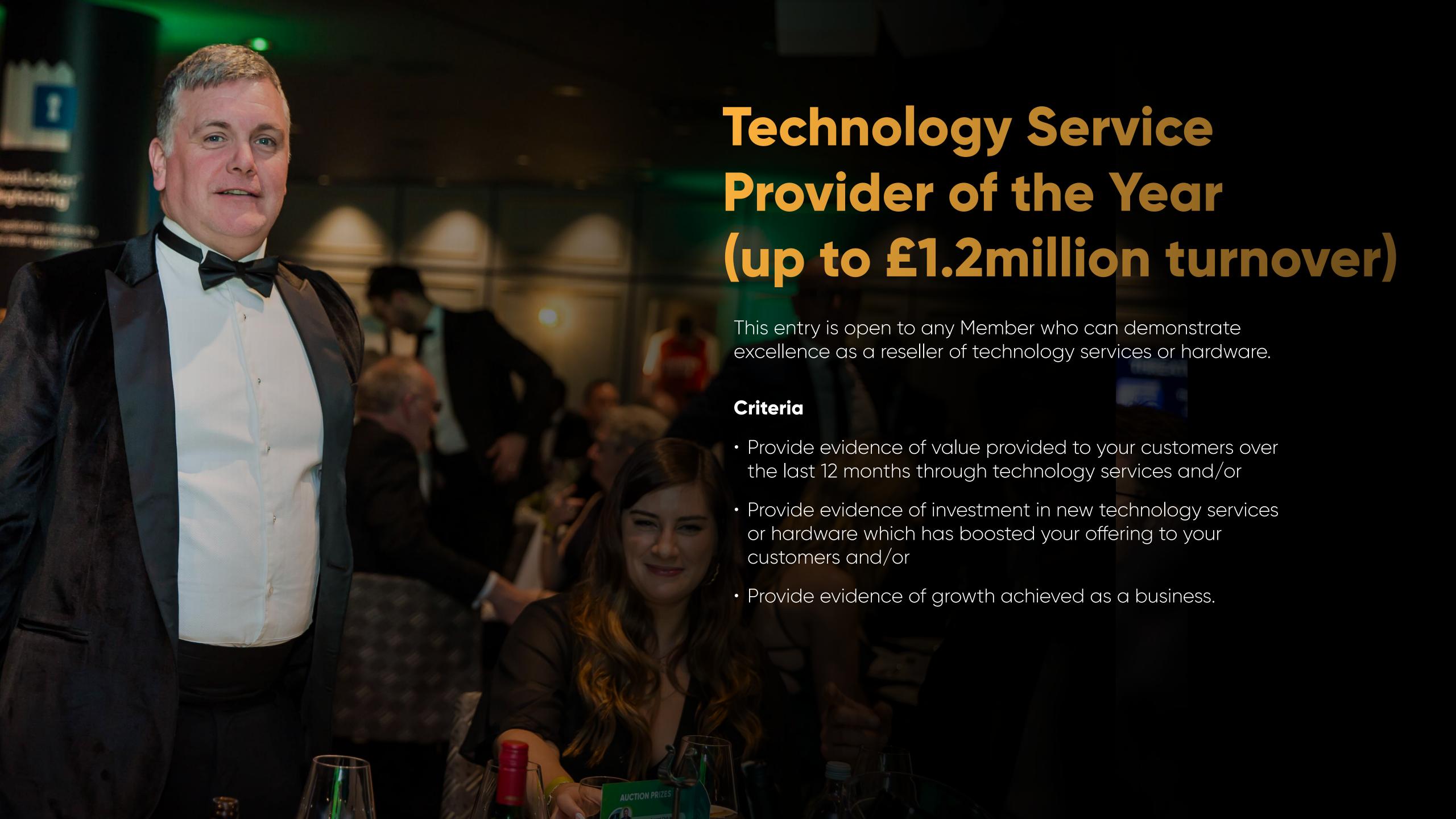
Outline

- Categories are FREE to enter
- One entry per category only. Multiple entries in the same category are not allowed and will be disqualified, with the NG HQ team picking just one entry to be submitted.
- We are actively encouraging you to enter for more than one award if the category is relevant to the business. Every entry MUST be different, any duplications will be disqualified.
- Please keep the entry relevant to the Group.
- The period covered for the awards entries is between 1st January 2024 and 31st December 2024.
- Written submissions should not exceed 500 words; video entries should be no more than 2-minutes in length. You can submit both a written and video entry for the same category.
- Written entries should be submitted in pdf or word document, videos should be sent via a link, ideally YouTube.
- Network Group reserves the right to move an entry to another category if the HQ Team see fit, and to drop categories that are not adequately entered.
- You can nominate another company in any of the other categories where applicable
- You do not have to meet every single criteria listed, however you will likely be scored higher for accurately meeting more criteria.
- Each nomination will be reviewed by HQ team, with a supporting comment including facts and figures where required to supplement the entry and provide additional context.

MSP of the Year (up to £2.5million turnover)

This entry is open to any Network Group member who manages less than 1500 endpoints and/or has annual turnover of <£2.5 million

- Provide evidence of value provided to your customers over the last 12 months through your services and/or
- Provide evidence of investment in new systems, vendor accreditations, or new services provided to boost your offering to your customers and/or
- Provide evidence of growth achieved as a business.

MSP of the Year (£2.5million+ turnover)

This entry is open to any Network Group member who manages more than 1500 endpoints and/or has annual turnover of >£2.5 million

- Provide evidence of value provided to your customers over the last 12 months through your services and/or
- Provide evidence of investment in new systems, vendor accreditations, or new services provided to boost your offering to your customers and/or
- Provide evidence of growth achieved as a business.



Telco Service Provider of the Year

This entry is open to any Network Group Member who provides Telecoms. Entries must be based on an installation completed in the last 12 months.

- Provide details of your customer's needs and pain points.
- Describe the deployment of the solution, including support provided and steps taken to minimise disruption.
- Provide evidence of how you met/exceeded customer expectations.
- Provide evidence of the impact and value the solution has had for your customer.
- Include a customer testimonial.





New Member of the Year

This entry is open to any Network Group Member who joined during or after January 2024.

- Provide evidence of how Network Group has improved your business and/or
- Provide evidence of your engagement with the Group with any of the following;
 - Actively attending and engaging at Network Group events
 - Number of Network Group Preferred Partners engaged with
 - Submitting monthly spend reporting to NG HQ
 - · Leading introductions and negotiations with potential new partners
 - Sharing experiences, providing examples and advice to Members
 - Actively engaging with the Group outside of events, i.e. via Slack/ WhatsApp/Community Calls



Member Initiative of the Year

This entry is open to any Member who has implemented new initiatives within their business to improve company culture or best practices.

- Provide evidence of initiatives implemented, i.e. 4-day work week, flexible working policies, Mental Health training and/or
- Provide evidence of the positive impact the initiative(s) have had on the business and/or
- Provide evidence of sustainability initiatives i.e. electric vehicle fleet, office energy efficiency (solar panels etc), reducing/changing packaging on shipped goods, electronics recycling etc
- Provide staff testimonials



- Open to any Network Group Member with at least one marketing employee.
- Entries can be for individual marketing staff or on behalf of the marketing team.
- Entry to include campaign description (what was the campaign & who was it aimed at), methods and tactics used (e.g. social media, PR, events etc), why it stands out and what you are most proud of, how successful was it (facts & figures to demonstrate ROI), and any relevant testimonials.
