The Community Chest 'Superheroes Campaign' saw 58 Comrades runners raising R799 879 for Community Chest Durban and Pietermaritzburg, official charities of the Comrades Marathon Association. All funds were donated to Early Childhood Development centres supporting over 7 845 children daily.

Early childhood development is crucial for mental, physical, and social development, with research showing significant brain growth during this period. ECD fosters lifelong learning, cognitive development, social skills, and independence, and helps identify developmental issues early.
