Kathie Bassler - Barge/Container Project: Ms. Bassler addressed the board the importance of transparency community, the community is worried scared and concerned regarding project. Need a strategic plan of commercial community should be residential. Too many unanswered questions regarding the container barge project for taxpayers and voters.

Miller Bassler – Barge/Container Project: Mr. Bassler addressed the board that he appreciates to be given the opportunity to speak. Mr. Bassler stated that earlier this morning he watched across the Harbor Queuing area, saw about 10 boats, counted about 3 dozen vehicles driving into Raymondville and asked himself "what will it look like when 18 wheelers are driving through the same road and people with children and boats."
