Item No. 1: REVIEW & CONSIDERATION OF PREVIOUS BOARD MEETING MINUTES: After reviewing August 05, 2025 board meeting minutes. Supervisor Alanis made the motion to approve the board meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Hess and the vote carried.

Item No. 3: DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ENFORCEMENT PROCESS FOR WATER RESTRICTIONS: After discussion on the enforcement process for water restrictions, the board decided to appoint water enforcers to give out citations. The district will have the support of the police department to assist with our appointed water enforcers to issue the warnings. The citation/fines will be added to the utility bills. All warnings will be added on the customer utility account. The warnings will be supported by the police department/water enforcer effective September 02, 2025. Citations issued by the water enforcer as are follow:

Second Warning -\$100.00 Third Warning -\$250.00 Fourth plus warnings \$500.00

Supervisor Alanis made the motion to assign Frank Vasquez and Susan Nelson as the Water Enforcers. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Machen and vote carried.

Item No. 4: <u>DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON DEVELOPING AND CONTRACTURAL AGREEMENT WITH A GROUP TO DEVELOP ARTESIAN WELL FOR WATER SOURCE OR ALTERNATE:</u> After discussion on developing and contractural agreement with a group to develop artesian well for water source or alternate, Supervisor Hess would like to focus on our existing assets, which include the well in San Perlita. Testing the Artisan Well, possibly to create reverse osmosis. Supervisor Alanis made the motion to have a presentation for possible reverse osmosis using our artesian well and the possibility of the district creating its own water. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Hess and motion carried.
