10 QUESTIONS THAT REVEAL WHETHER YOUR DATA IS **ACTUALLY** **USABLE**



10 Questions That Reveal Whether Your Data Is Actually Usable

Answer yes or no. Be honest. Nobody's grading this except your next audit.

1. Can you produce every grower's enrollment record without emailing three people? ☐ Y ☐ N
2. Does every field rep or grower submit data the same way, every time? ☐ Y ☐ N
3. Are your verification photos geotagged and timestamped? ☐ Y ☐ N
4. Could you tie a specific payment to a specific piece of verification evidence right now? ☐ Y ☐ N
5. Do you know, today, exactly who has and hasn't been paid this cycle? ☐ Y ☐ N
6. If your program lead left tomorrow, could someone else find and explain the data? ☐ Y ☐ N
7. Can you generate a funder-ready report in under a day? ☐ Y ☐ N
8. Is your grower data structured at the field level, not just "somewhere in a spreadsheet"? ☐ Y ☐ N
9. Could this same dataset be reused for a different program without re-collecting it? ☐ Y ☐ N
10. Would your data hold up if a funder or auditor asked to see it tomorrow? ☐ Y ☐ N

Your Score

8–10 yes

Solid ground. You're closer to a Farm Data Passport than most programs — worth checking where the remaining gaps are.

5–7 yes

Workable, but you're patching holes. A few of these gaps are the ones that show up during an audit.

0–4 yes

Your data is running on hope and a shared spreadsheet. That's expensive the moment someone official asks to see it.

If you answered no to five or more, you're not alone. This is the most common place ag programs get stuck. The good news: every one of these gaps is fixable with the right system, not more headcount.
